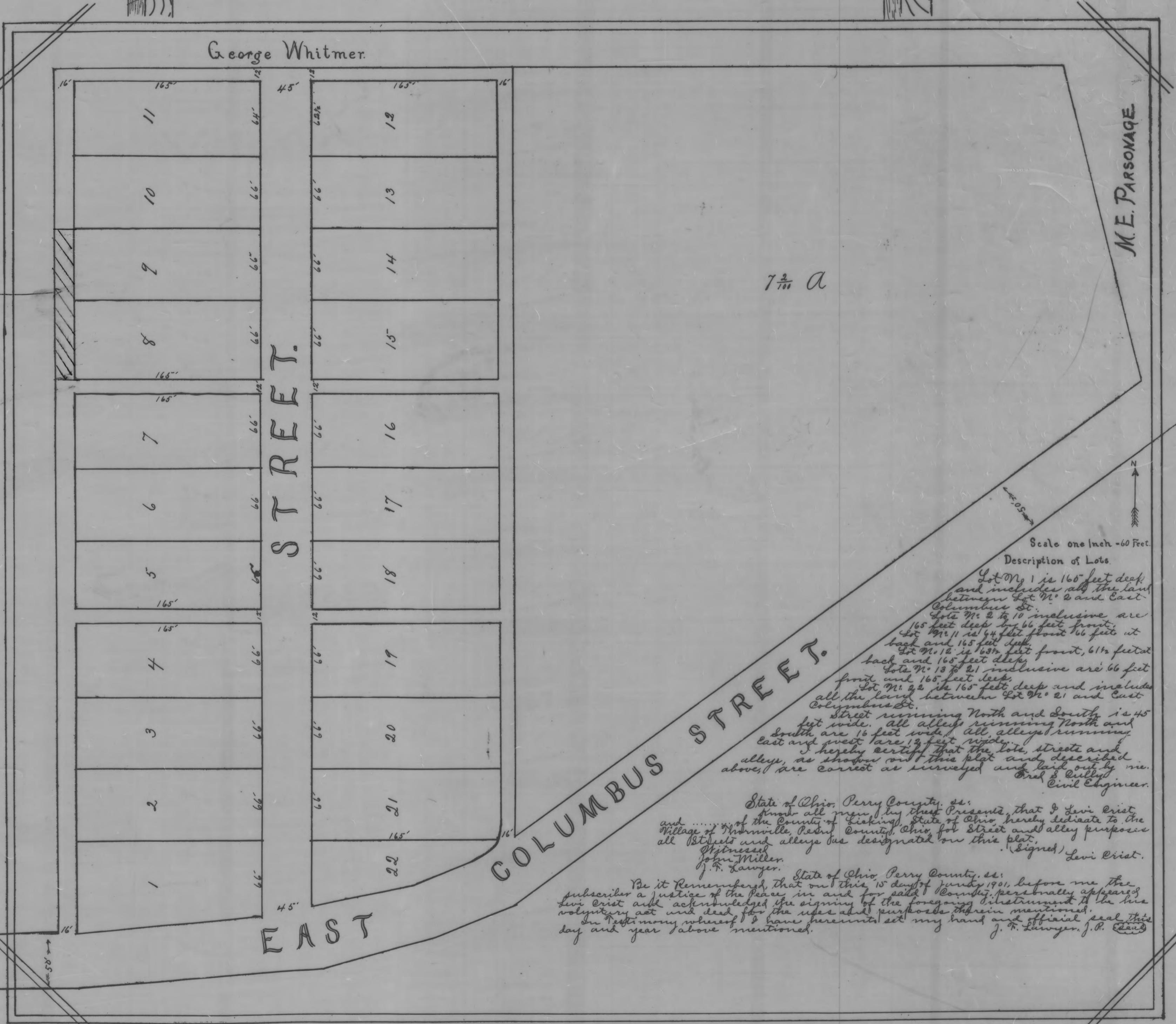


# LEVICRIST' ADDITION TO THORNVILLE, PERRY COUNTY, OHIO.

Description of Lots

Lot No. 1 is 160 feet deep and includes all the land between Lot No. 2 and East Columbus St.  
 Lots No. 2 to 19 inclusive are 165 feet deep by 66 feet front.  
 Lot No. 11 is 64 feet front 66 feet at back and 165 feet deep.  
 Lot No. 12 is 165 feet front, 61 1/2 feet at back and 165 feet deep.  
 Lots No. 13 to 21 inclusive are 66 feet front and 165 feet deep.  
 Lot No. 22 is 165 feet deep and includes all the land between Lot No. 21 and East Columbus St.  
 Street running North and South is 45 feet wide. All alleys running North and South are 16 feet wide. All alleys running East and West are 12 feet wide.  
 I hereby certify that the lots, streets and alleys, as shown on this plat and described above, are correct as surveyed and laid out by me.
