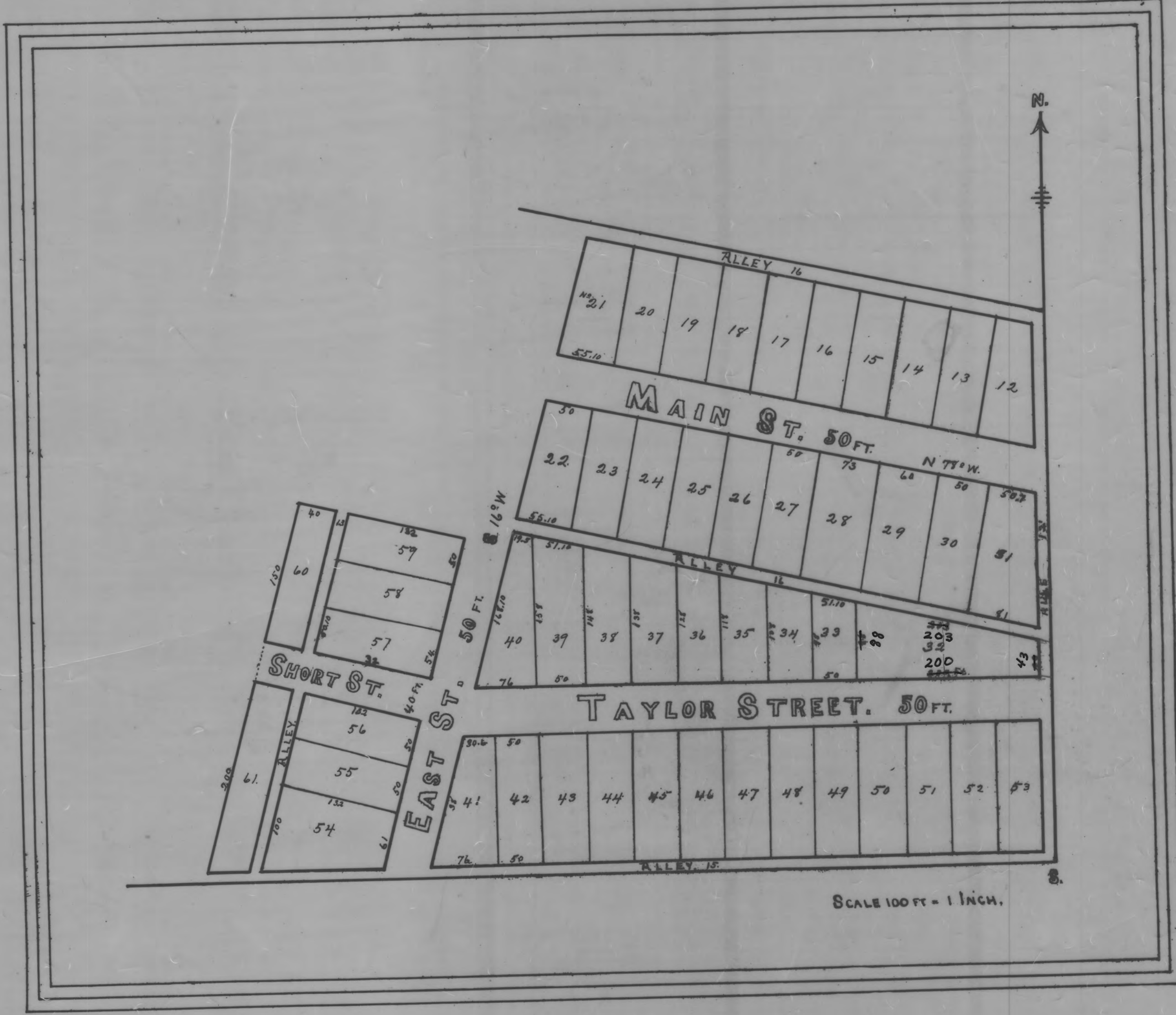


GULICK'S FIRST ADDITION TO THE VILLAGE OF CUMKEEVER.



Commencing at a stone at the North East corner of the South East quarter of Section 17, Township 14, Range 14. Thence South 12 chains & 13 links; Thence N 78° W 4 chains & 81 links to the place of beginning; thence N 78° W 7 chains & 57 links; Thence S 14° W 6 chains & 29 links; Thence East 14 chains; Thence North 8 chains & 97 links to the place of beginning. Containing 9 7/100 acres.
