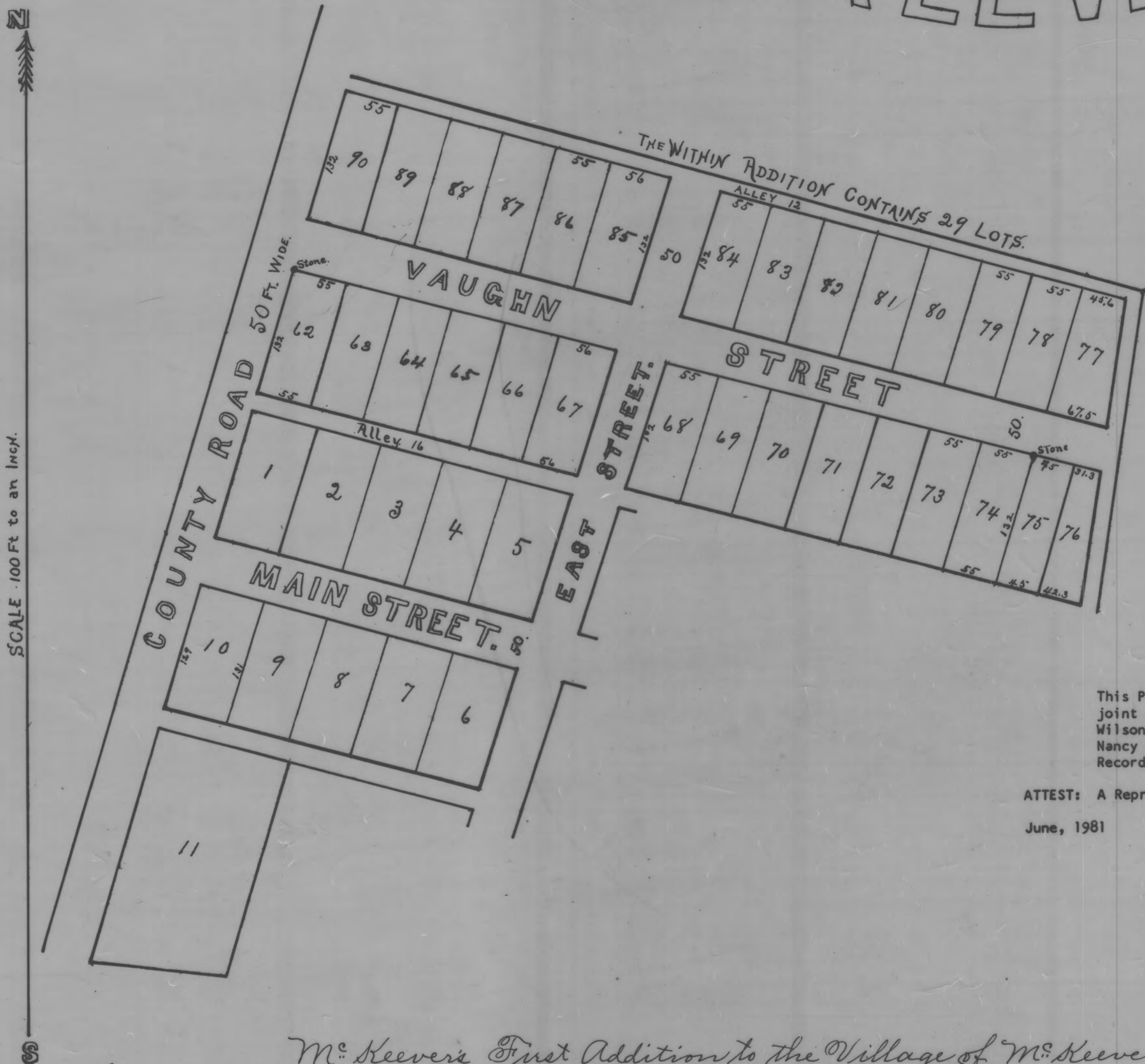


# M<sup>c</sup>KEEVER'S FIRST ADDITION TO M<sup>c</sup>KEEVER.

*M<sup>c</sup>Keever's First Addition to the Village of M<sup>c</sup>Keever. Commencing at the North West corner of Lot No. 1 in the Village of M<sup>c</sup>Keever, thence N 16° E 16 feet to the place of beginning; thence N 16° E 342 feet; thence S 78° E 715.5 feet; thence S 8° W 32.4 feet; thence N 78° W 75.9 feet to the place of beginning, containing 5<sup>6</sup>/<sub>100</sub> acres, the lots contain 1/10 of an acre, except Lot No. 75 & 76 which contain 1/100 of an acre. Lot 76 contains 1/100 of an acre.*

*The original plat which includes Lots 1 to 11, inclusive was changed so as to give Main Street the same bearing (S 78° E) as Kulick's, a Trustee's Addition to said Village. The lots in the Town proper contain 1/10 of an acre.*
