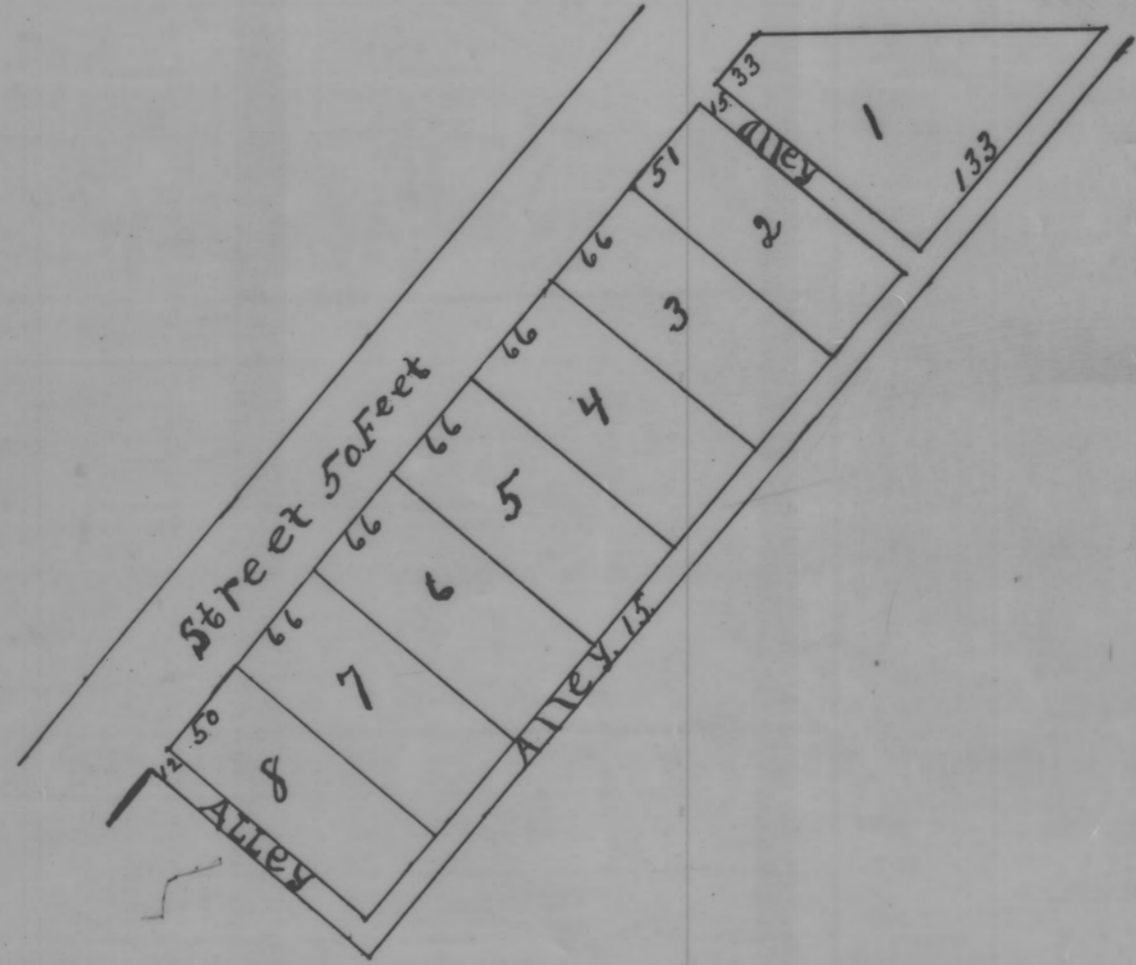

Being part of the South West Quarter of Section 16, Township 14, Range 14, and Commencing at the north east corner of said quarter, thence South 112.5 feet, thence N 86° W 260 ft. to the place of beginning thence N 86° W 149 feet, thence S 41° E W. 557 ft, thence South 57 1/2 East 147 ft, thence N 41 1/2° E 657 ft to the place of beginning containing 1 7/8 Acres.

Lots 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 + 7 each contain 29/100 of an acre. Lot 1 contains 25/100 Acres. Lot 8 contains 1/100 Acres.
