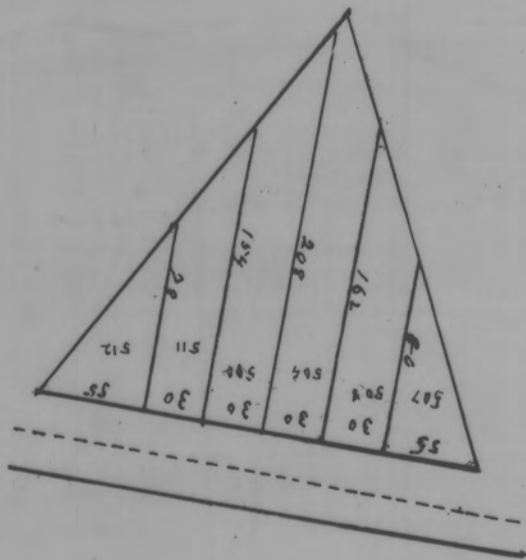


BRANNON HULL AND BURLY'S
