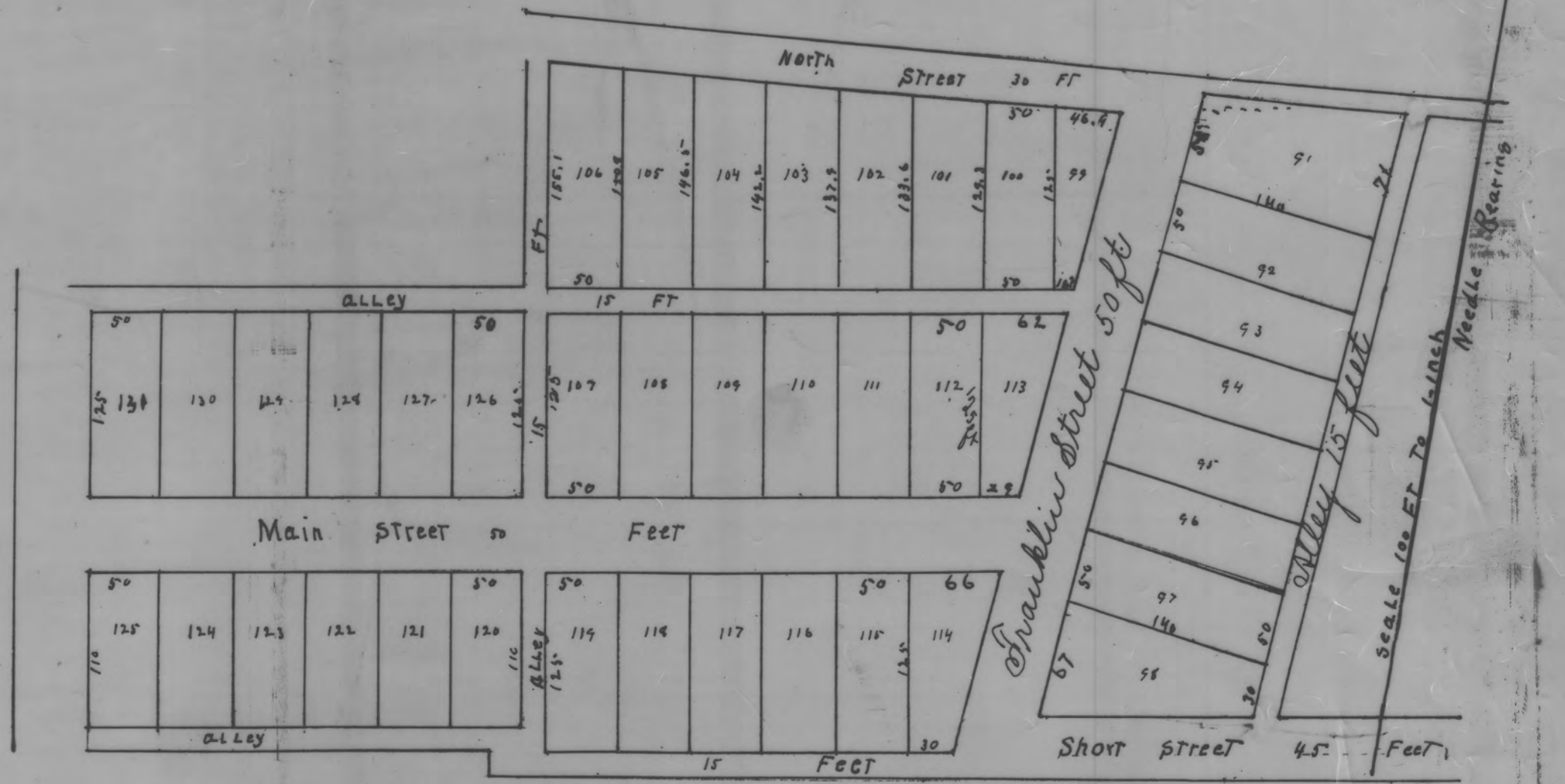


# TERRACE ADDITION TO McKEEVER
