We the undersigned proprietors and owners in fee of certain Real Estate conveyed to us by Charles H. Poland and wife by Deed dated April 20th A.D. 1903, being part of the North-East quarter of Section Fourteen (14) Township fourteen (14) Range fourteen (14) in Jewell Land District in the County of Perry in the State of Ohio. The Deed for the said premises being recorded in Record of Deeds for Perry County, Ohio, in Book 62, at Page 224, to which reference is hereby had and made. We have caused the said premises to be surveyed and divided into Lots, Streets and Alleys as shown by the foregoing Plat.

And named the said subdivisions, and wish it to be hereafter known as Shurest Addition to Roseville. There is Ten Acres of land in the said Addition which is subdivided into Fifty Lots or separate parcels of land, and numbered from 325 to 374 inclusive. The width and depth of all of the said Lots are marked thereon in feet, or in feet and fraction of a foot. The width of the Streets and Alleys are also marked in feet and fraction of a foot. The said Addition is bounded by beginning at a Locust Post planted at the South West corner of the Roseville Cemetery, thence West 40 rods, North 40 rods, East 40 rods, South 40 rods to the place of beginning, containing 10 Acres of land. We dedicate all streets and Alleys shown on the Plat to the use of the public as public highways.
