

BROWN'S ADDITION to ROSEVILLE

I the undersigned owner and proprietor of land in the North East quarter of Section Four (4) Township Fourteen Range Fourteen in the Jamesville Sdhd District in the County of Perry and State of Ohio, being the same premises conveyed to me by F. F. Melick and Wife by deed dated September 30, A.D. 1879, recorded in Record of Deeds for Perry County, Ohio, in Book 123, Page 306 + 1/2. I have caused a part of the said Real Estate to be surveyed and sub-divided into Lots, Streets and Alleys as shown by the foregoing Plat and have named the said sub-division and wish it to be known hereafter as Browns Addition to Roseville. There is in the said sub-division 2.53 Acres of land. There is in the said Addition ten Lots, numbered from 375 to 384 inclusive, and all are of the number of feet front and depth as marked on the Plat in feet, or in feet and fractions of a foot, the Streets and Alleys are of the width as marked on the Plat in feet. Stones are planted at all corners marked Stone, from which to make and regulate future surveys. The foregoing Plat correctly represents the said Addition as I verily believe. 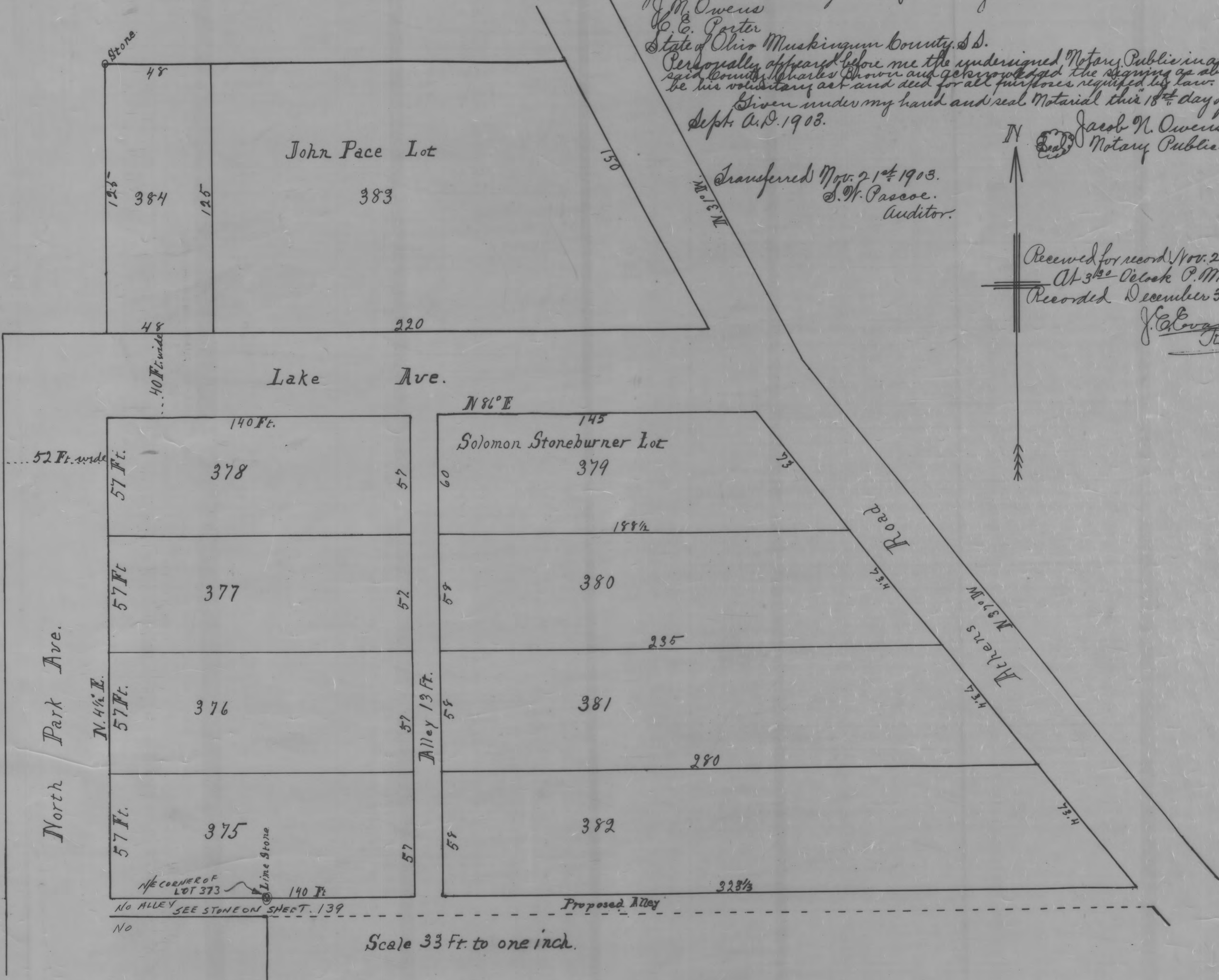
