Brannon Hull & Burley's Addition to the Village of Crooksville, Ohio, commencing at the Northwest corner of the North East quarter section 20 Township 14, Range 14, thence S. 86 degrees East 20 chains and 63 links, thence S. 42° 6.8 chains + 53 links to a stone, thence S. 17° 2 E. 12 chains and 87 links to the place of beginning, thence S. 77° E. 2.45 feet, thence South 28° West 264 feet, thence North 32° West 253 feet to the place of beginning containing 7 1/100 ac.

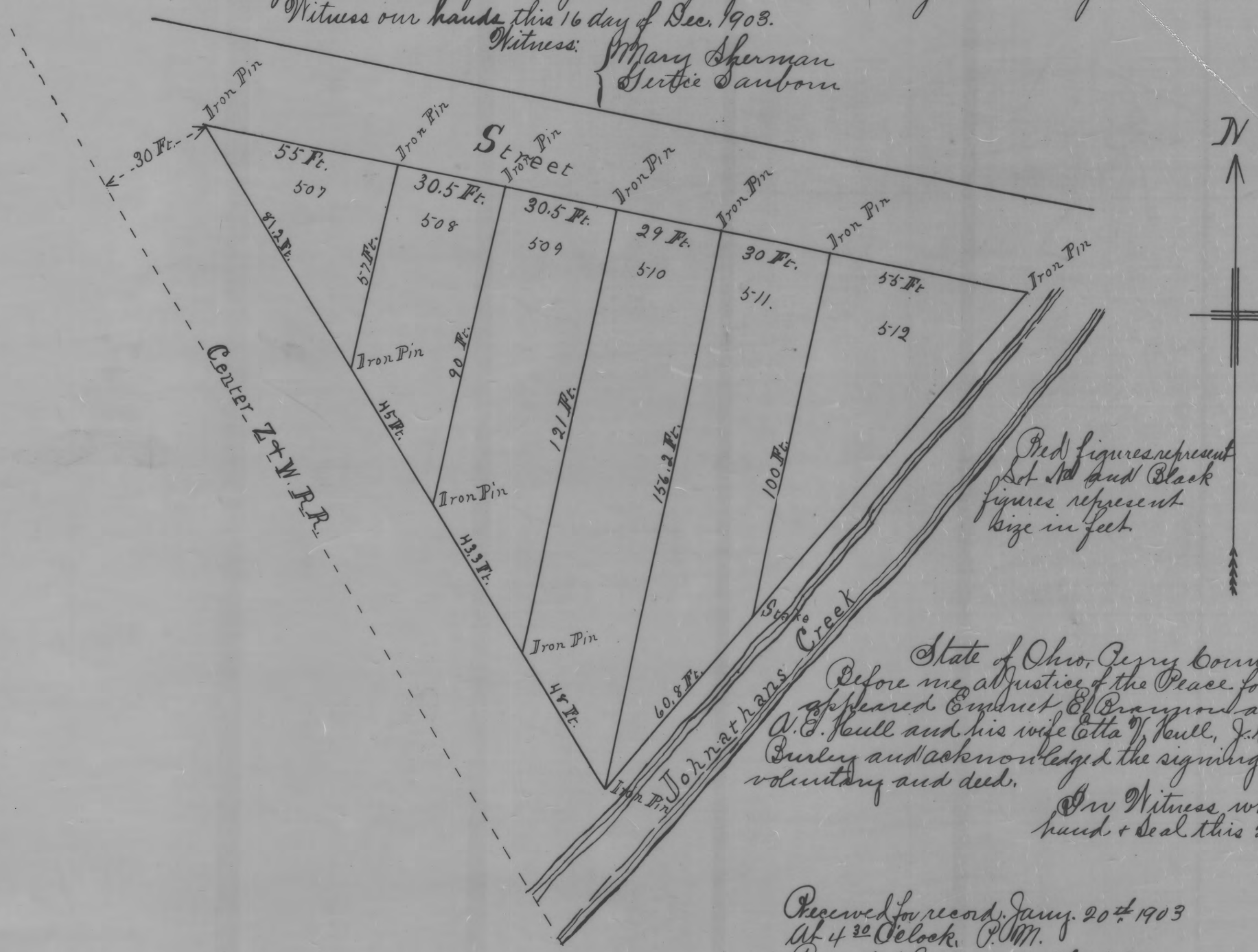

We the undersigned who were formerly owners and proprietors of the lands included in what is known as Brannon Hull & Burley's first addition to the Village of Crooksville, Perry County, Ohio, that we dedicate the streets to the Public for use as Public highways & that this Plat is made to correct any error in the depths of said lots which is recorded in Plat Book 3 Page 131, which plat gave fuller description of land laid out in lots, but by inadvertance of Surveyor the length of each lot was given wrong and this Plat is to cure that defect.
