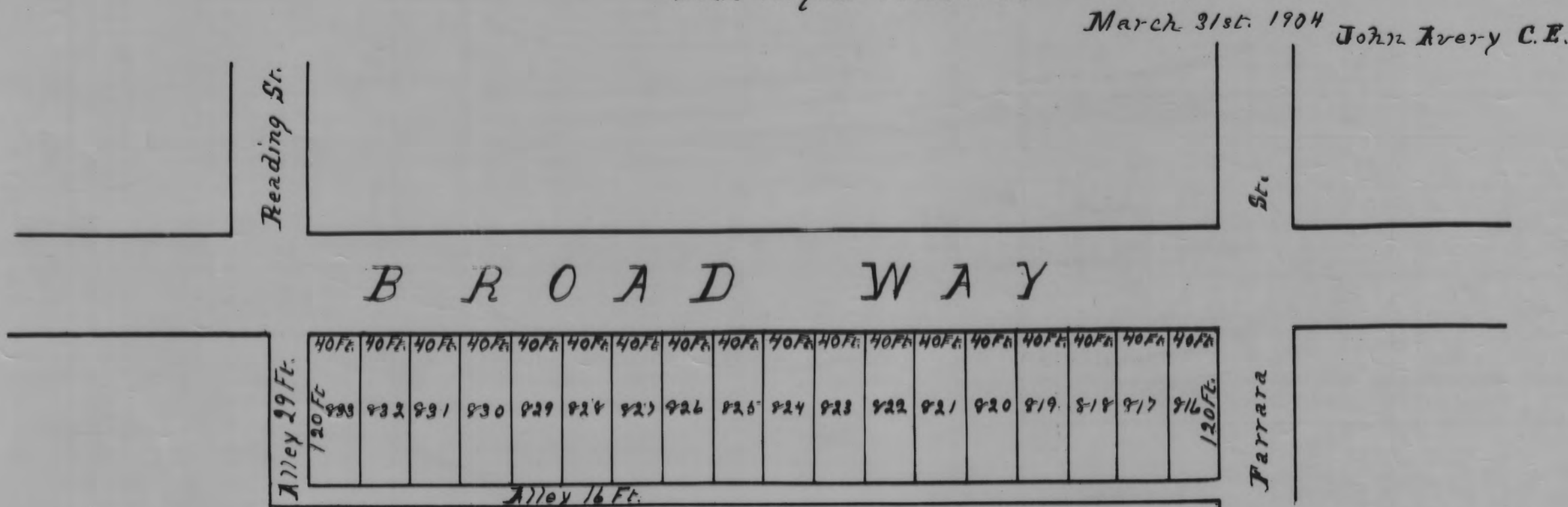


T. J. TRACY'S SECOND ADDITION TO NEW LEXINGTON

This tract is part of the south east quarter of section 5, township 15, range 15, Perry County, Ohio. Beginning at the south east corner of said quarter section, thence north 303.4 feet, to the center of Broadway, thence west 1085.6 feet, thence south 40 feet, to the place of beginning. Thence west 749 feet, thence south 136 feet, thence east 749 feet, thence north 136 feet, to the place of beginning. Containing 2 1/2 acres. This tract was platted, extending from Broadway to the C. & M. V. R. R. right of way, but was vacated by order of Court. The lots are numbered the same as on the original plat.
