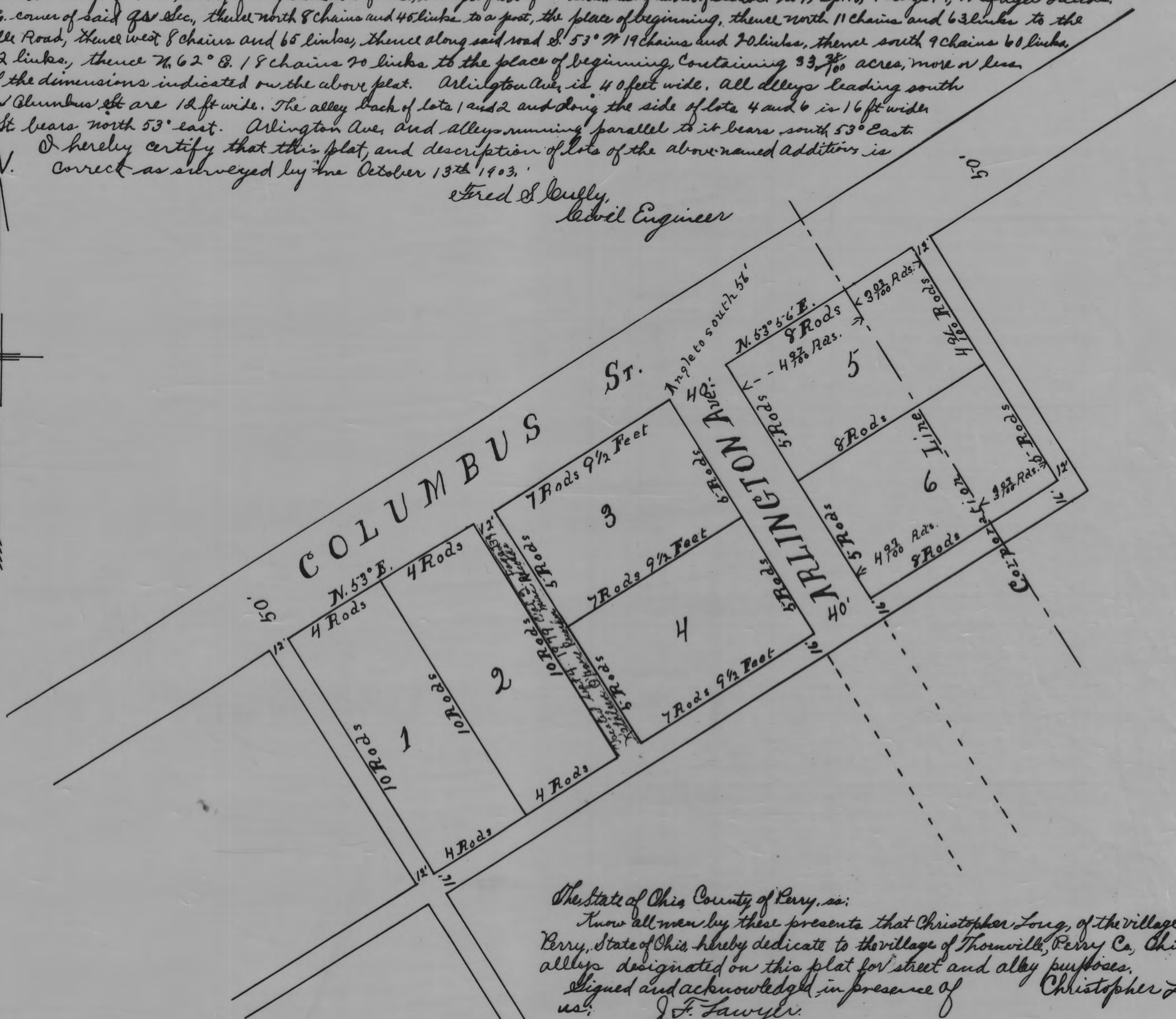
Christopher Long's second Addition to Thornville, Perry Co, Ohio abuts on Columbus Street, and is a part of the following described tract of land:

Situated in the Township of Thorn, County of Perry, State of Ohio, being a part of the southeast quarter of Section No 9, T. 18, R. 17, Refugee Lands. Commencing at the S.E. corner of said 9th Sec., thence north 8 chains and 45 links to a post, the place of beginning, thence north 11 chains and 63 links to the Thornville and Jansville Road, thence west 8 chains and 65 links, thence along said road S. 53° W 19 chains and 70 links, thence south 9 chains 60 links, thence east 7 ch. 92 links, thence N. 62° E. 18 chains 70 links to the place of beginning, containing 33, 3/4 acres, more or less.

The lots are of the dimensions indicated on the above plat. Arlington Ave. is 40 feet wide. All alleys leading south easterly from Columbus St are 12 ft wide. The alley back of lots 1 and 2 and along the side of lots 4 and 6 is 16 ft wide. Columbus St bears north 53° east. Arlington Ave. and alleys running parallel to it bears south 53° East.
