

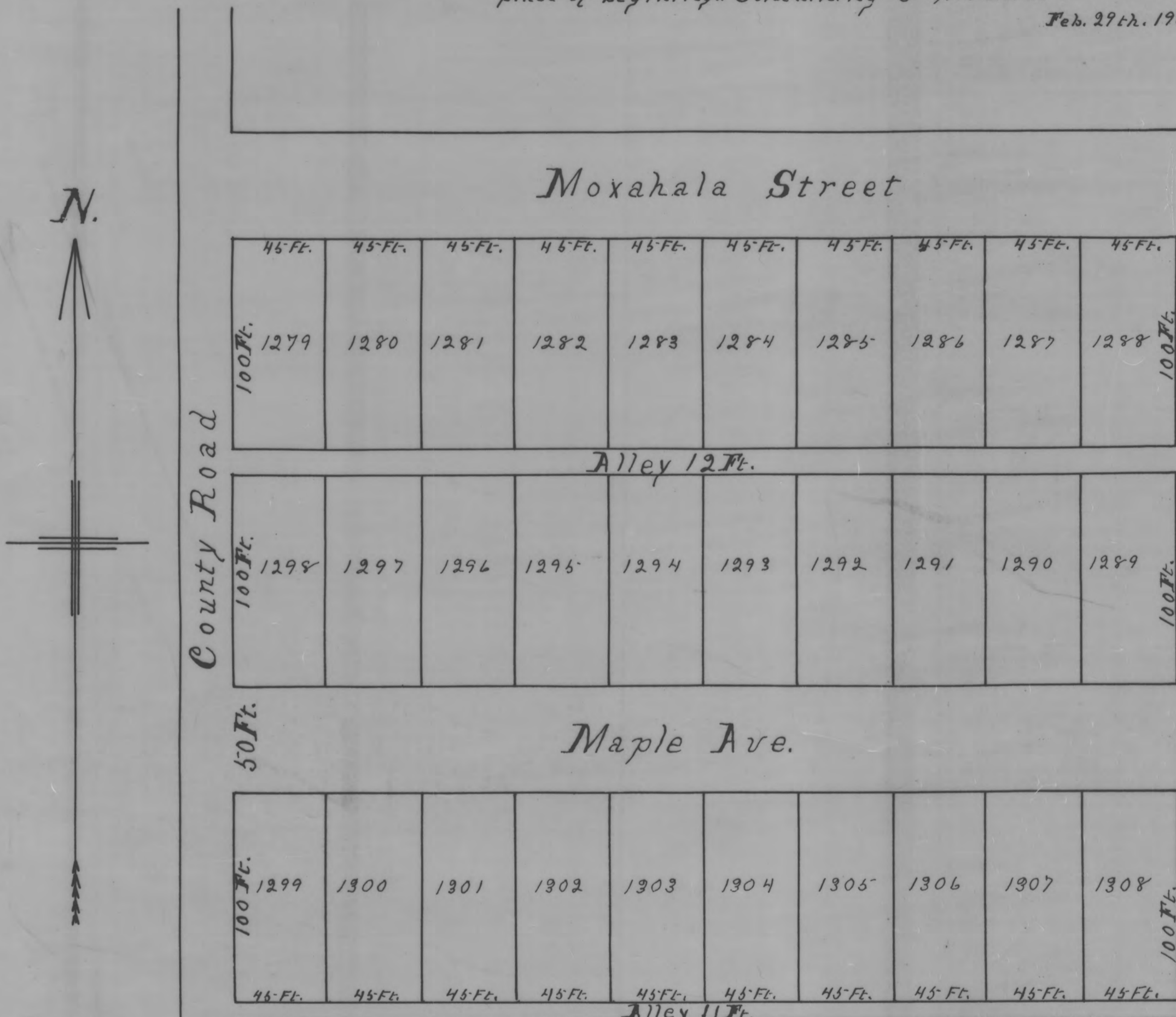

Strosnider as an Addition to the Village of New Lexington, Ohio, be and the same hereby is approved, in so far as the laying out of the lots, street and alleys, is concerned without any acceptance of the dedication of the streets and alleys by said Addition, and without any liability attaching to said Village to improve or keep up said streets and alleys in repair.
