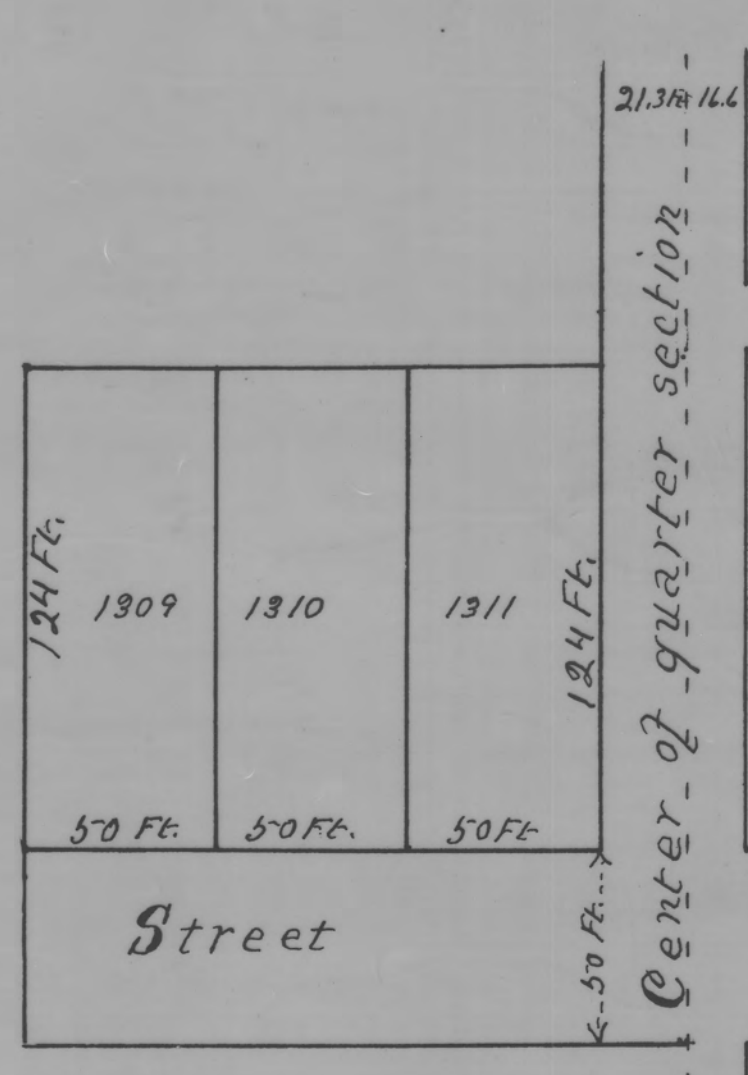


# D. C. FOWLER'S Addition to NEW LEXINGTON
