

The State of Ohio, Perry County, S. S.
In the matter of the application to attach certain territory to the Village of Corning, Perry County, Ohio,
for incorporation purposes.

Petitioners,
To The Hon. Board of Commissioners of Perry County, Ohio:-

The undersigned persons residents of this County of Perry and in the territory hereinafter described, and being a majority of adult property owners living therein, and desiring to have attached to the Village of Corning, Perry County, Ohio, the territory hereinafter described, which we desire to become part of the said Village of Corning for incorporation purposes, said territory lying and being adjacent said Village and being described as follows:-
Commencing at the southwest corner of Lot No. 386 of the Village of Ferrara Perry County, Ohio, which is now attached to the said Village of Corning for incorporation purposes, thence running south eight feet to a half section line, running east and west through Section 15 of Monroe Township this County, thence running west on said half section line 292 feet to the place of beginning and thence running north 160 feet to a point 16 feet west and 60 feet north of the north-west corner of Lot No. 149 of the Village of Ferrara this County, said point being on the north side of Oak Street of said Village of Ferrara; thence running east along the north side of said Oak Street 392 feet to a point; thence running north 76 feet to a point; thence running east along the south side of Sycamore Street of said Village 612 feet to a point 60 feet east of the north-east corner of Lot No. 322 of said Village of Ferrara and on the east side of Jefferson Street of said Village; thence running south along the east side of Jefferson Street 760 feet to the north line of Oak Street of said Village of Ferrara; thence east along the north side of Oak Street 250 feet; thence south 860 feet to the present corporation line of the said Village of Corning and being the north boundary line of said incorporation of Corning, thence following said present line of said Village of Corning west and south to the place of beginning. All of said territory being located in the north-west quarter of Section 15 of Monroe Township, Perry County, Ohio, and being that part of the Village of Ferrara and adjacent territory as included within the Red Ink lines of the Plat hereto attached, which said plat is made part hereof and marked "Exhibit A."

Your Petitioners hereby appoint T. M. Potter of the Village of Ferrara aforesaid to act as their Agent in the premises. And your petitioners hereby ask of your Honorable Board that such steps maybe taken as require by law to the end that the territory described in the Plat hereto attached may be attached to the said Village of Corning this County and may for incorporation purposes become part thereof.

After day the above application came on for hearing before the Board of Commissioners of Perry County, Ohio, at the regular quarterly session, and said board being fully advised of the premises, hereby order the Petition and Plat thereof filed with the County Auditor, and does hereby fix the time of the final hearing of said application for Monday, the 7th day of November, 1904, and hereby order T. M. Potter the Agent of the Petitioners in this matter, to give six weeks notice of the time and place of hearing of said application, and of the substance of the petition, in some News Paper printed and of general circulation in this County, and also post in some conspicuous place, within the limits of the territory so proposed to be attached, for six weeks prior to the time hearing, a copy of said notice.

This day came T. M. Potter, the Agent of the Petitioners in the above matter and presented the proof of the publication of the News Paper notice and of the posting of a copy of said notice in the territory herein sought to be attached to said Village of Corning and upon examination of the same, we find said notice contains all facts required by law to be stated and that the same has been given in all respects in conformity with the statutes in such case made, and provided and in conformity to the orders heretofore made by us herein, thereupon said notice and proof is herewith ordered filed and approved, and confirmed and made part of the record in this cause.

Thereupon this matter coming on for public hearing upon the petition, exhibits and evidence read upon consideration whereof and of the evidence produced and being fully advised in the premises, we find that said petition contains all matters required by law, that each and all the allegations and facts stated in said application herein are true, and no objection, agency or bar has been entered thereto.

We further find that the limits of said proposed annexation are accurately described; that the map thereof and attached thereto is accurate; that the petitioners whose names are signed to said application constitute a majority of the adult free holders residing in said territory and further that it seems to us right that the prayer of the petition be granted.

Therefore, it is this day ordered that said territory described in the petition and attached map thereof in this proceeding be and the same hereby is attached to the said Village of Corning, Perry County, Ohio, as prayed for in said petition, subject to the approval of the County Auditor. It is further ordered that a full transcript of all the proceedings had by us herein, together with the petition and accompanying map of said territory, be and the same hereby is ordered forthwith to be deposited with the Clerk of the Village of Corning, Perry County, Ohio, for safe keeping in accordance with law.

Notice is hereby given that on the 5th day of September, 1904, there was filed in the Office of the Commissioners of Perry County, Ohio, a petition for the purpose of attaching certain parts of the Village of Ferrara to the Village of Corning, Perry County, Ohio, that on said day the Commissioners at the regular session for September 1904, did then and there fix the time and place of hearing of said petition and application for the 7th day of November, 1904, at the hour of 10 O'clock, A.M. at their office in the Court House in Lexington, Ohio, and that any and all persons interested therein may appear at said time and place and be heard either for or against said proposed attachment. That said territory described in said petition and which is sought to be attached is as follows:
