

Plat of Melick's Addition to Roseville, Ohio.

The Plat hereon constructed represents Melick's Addition to the Village of Roseville, O. and is situated in the north-west corner of that certain lot, or tract of land, now owned by David L. Melick, containing 13.32 acres, lying immediately in the north east corner of Section No. Four (4) in Township No. Fourteen (14) of Range No. Thirteen (13) in the United States Congress district of land; being in Harrison Township, Perry County, Ohio. All as shown on the Plat and comprising an area of 5.25 acres of land.

The lots are numbered from 1 to 23 inclusive. Stakes are set at all lot corners. Courses are noted at present magnetic decimals. Monuments are set at points marked thus: ⊕ Distances as noted on the Plat in feet and
