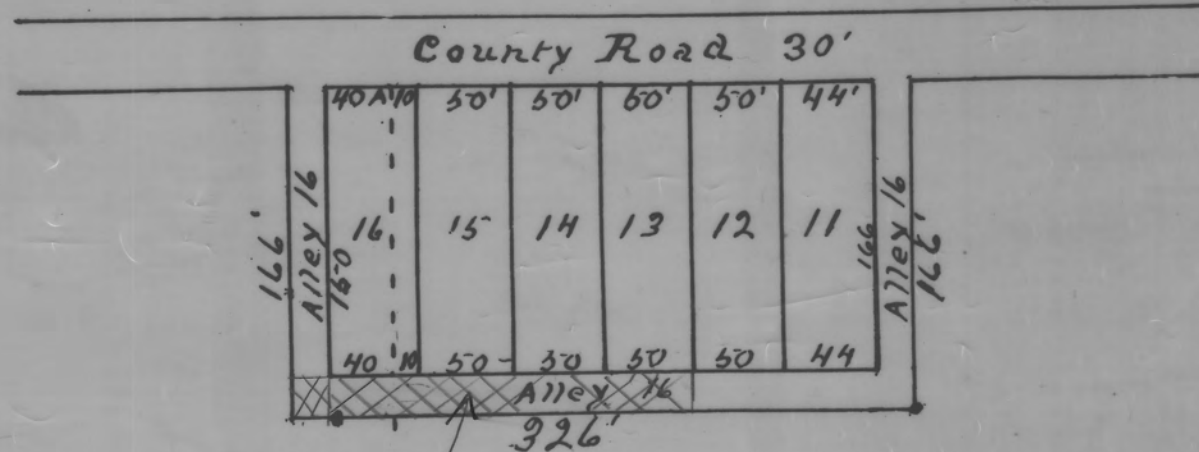


# DANIEL SAYER'S

The following land was surveyed for Daniel Sayer Oct 12<sup>th</sup> 1904, for Lots situated in Bearfield Township, Perry County, State of Ohio, there being 9296 square feet, taking out of the North-east corner of the north-west 1/4 of Section 23, Also one acre and 1260 square feet, taken out of the north-west corner of the North-east 1/4 of the North-east 1/4 of Section 23, Town 13, Range 14, Bearfield Township of the above County and State. Commencing in the North-east corner of the above Plat, of the North-West 1/4 Section 23, in the above Township, Range, thence West 57 feet, thence south 166 feet, thence East 326 feet, thence North 166 feet to the South side of County road and on the Section line 270 feet to the place of commencing and containing 1 <sup>24</sup>/<sub>100</sub> acres.
