P.P. Mechlings First Addition to Glenford is a part of the N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 17, T. 17 R. 17, Perry Co. Ohio Beginning at a point in the County Road on the center of the street leading north and north 51° East 188.1 ft from a corner stone which stands on the half section line 23<sup>50</sup>/<sub>100</sub> chains south from the N.W. corner of said. 1/4 Sec. thence N 51° E 90.4 ft thence N. 62 1/2° East 201 ft. to the starting point. Thence 62 1/2° East 19 ft. thence N. 80° E 145.2 ft thence N. 67° East 182.1 ft. thence N. 20° W. 365.3 ft. thence S. 62 1/2° W. 7.7 ft thence S 74° W. 132 ft thence N. 56 1/2° W 101 ft. thence N. 57° W 60 ft. thence N. 74 1/2° W 50 ft. thence N. 68° W 117 ft. thence S 297.3 ft. thence E 286 ft. thence S 188.7 ft to the place of beginning.
