



Burley Winters, Third Addition to the Village of Crookville, Ohio  
 Being part of the North West quarter of Section 2, Township 14 Range 14  
 and commencing at the South East Corner of Lot 28 in Burley &  
 Winters, first Addition to the Village of Crookville, Harrison Township  
 Perry County, Ohio, thence S. 35° E. 58 1/2 feet to stake in road the place  
 of beginning thence S. 15° E. 1260 feet along the County road thence  
 S. 76 1/2° E. 314 feet thence N. 76 1/2° W. 1260 feet thence N. 76 1/2° W. 314 feet to the
