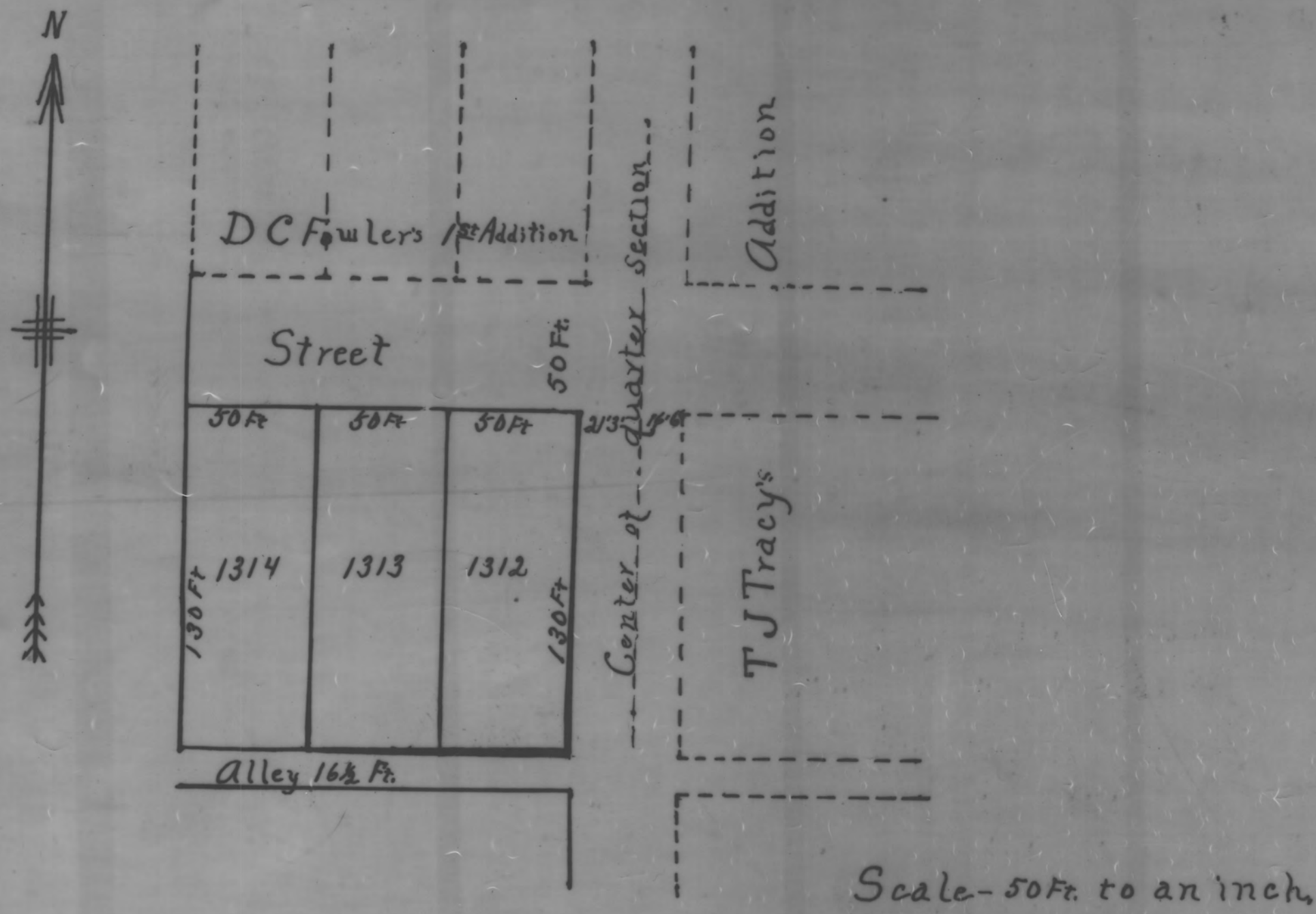


# D.C. FOWLER'S Second addition to NEW LEXINGTON



Dec. 21<sup>st</sup> 1906  
 This tract is a part of the north-west quarter of the south-east quarter of Section No. 9 of No. 15 Range No. 16 Perry Co. Ohio Beginning at a point 22 7/8 in south of the north-east corner of said quarter of a quarter section; thence west 171 ft. 3 in; thence south 146 1/2 ft.; thence east 171 ft. 3 in; thence north 146 1/2 ft. to the place of beginning, containing 5/8 of an acre.
