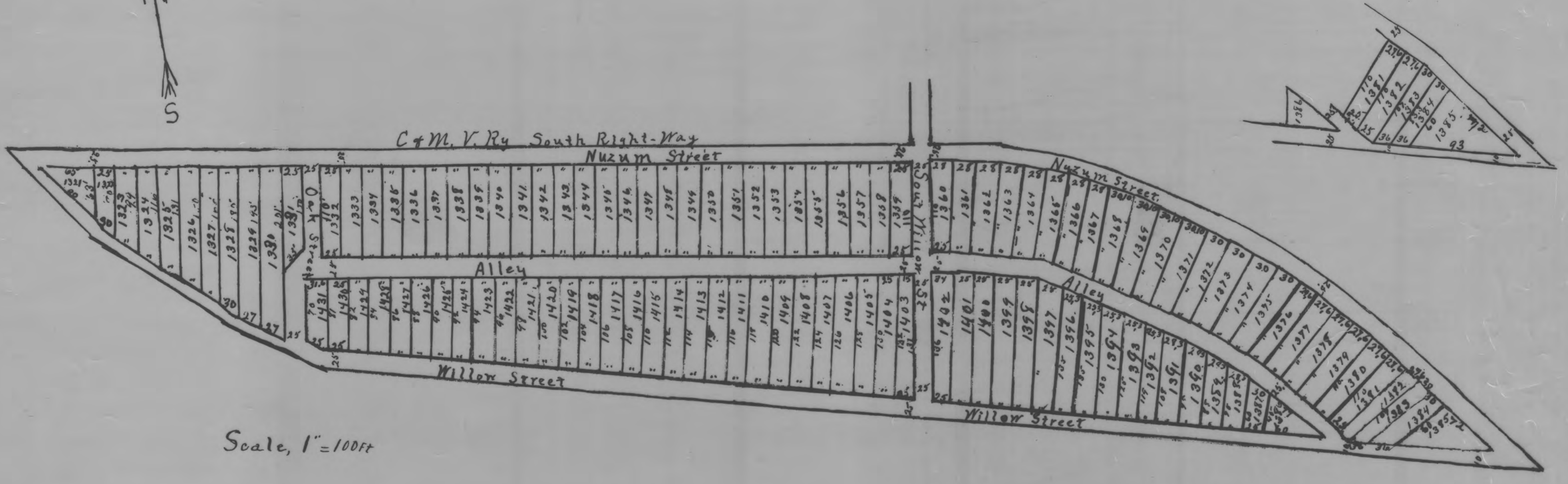


B.B. FRISTOE'S ADDITION TO

This Plat of Lots is situate in the North East Quarter of Section 8, Township 15 of Range 15, Perry County, Ohio and bounded as follows: Beginning at the South West corner of the North East quarter of Section 8, Township and range aforesaid: Thence north 27 1/2° East 271 1/2 ft; Thence South 80 1/2° East 255 ft; Thence South 5° West 45 ft to the place of beginning; Thence South 80 1/2° East 1134 ft to an Elm tree; Thence South 74 1/2° East 220 3/4 ft; thence South 58 1/4° East 174 ft; thence South 47 1/4° East 104 1/2 ft; Thence South 41° East 115 1/2 ft; Thence South 36° East 231 1/2 ft; Thence north 75 3/4° West 148 1/2 ft to a stake on the north bank of the Creek; thence north 56° West 113 1/2 ft; Thence north 46 1/2° West 189 3/4 ft, thence north 135 3/4° West 162 1/2 ft to the place of beginning & containing 8.8 acres more or less, John Baillie C.E. June 13, 1906.

Know All Men by these Presents that B. B. Fristoe and Gertrude Fristoe his wife the owners and Proprietors of lands embraced in the annexed plat and addition to the village of New-Lexington Ohio, does hereby lay out and make said addition to the said village and does hereby dedicate the Streets and Alleys shown on said plat, to the use forever for the uses & purposes of Streets and Alleys.
