The description of the aforesaid Street is as follows: Commencing in the center of China Street 25 ft west from the north west corner of Lot No. 676 Sec. 12, T. 20 N. R. 10 E. Penney's 2nd addition to Crooksville, Perry Co., Ohio, thence along the said Street South 12<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> West 81.3 ft, thence South 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> West 482.17 ft to the middle of an alley as above described and then terminates.
