Burley, + Miller's Second Addition to the Village of Cookeville is situated in the North West quarter of Section 21 Township 14 Range 14 Harrison Township Perry County, Ohio and described as follows: Commencing at the South East corner of Lot No. 37 in the first Add to said Village thence N. 72° W. 339 feet thence S. 46° 17' 0" E. 170 feet thence S. 77° 21' 4" E. 214.4 feet thence S. 108° 6' 21" E. 212 feet thence S. 72° 6' 19" E. 195 feet thence S. 14° 6' 28" E. 285 feet thence about 72° East 765.8 feet thence S. 42° W. 370 feet thence S. 72° W. 666 feet thence S. 22° 6' 12" East to the place of beginning containing 97 1/100 acres. The lots are numbered from 48 to 71, inclusive and contain one fifth of an acre being 66 by 132 feet except the following numbers which are of various sizes for which you will refer to plat No. 43, 46, 56, 57, 65, 70, and 71, which have their areas marked on plat also 146 + 149 as changed on plat.
