In the matter of Petition for annexation of certain contiguous territory of the village of Brooksville, Perry County, Ohio } Journal Entry
December 3, 1906

This day a petition of the corporation of the village Brooksville, Perry County, Ohio, was presented to the board of County Commissioners, applying for the annexation of certain contiguous territory to said village, and the board of County Commissioners being in regular session, and being fully advised in the premises, and the said petition setting forth that, under an ordinance of the council of said village passed September 4, 1906. The territory therein described was authorized to be annexed to the said village, and said petition containing an accurate description of the territory proposed for annexation, and being accompanied by an accurate map thereof, the Board thereupon ordered the petition and map thereof filed with the County Auditor, and hereby fix the time and place for hearing said petition for Friday Feb. 10, 1907, 10 o'clock A. M. at the commissioner's office, in the Court-house, in New Lexington, Ohio. The County Auditor is hereby directed to notify Emmett & Braumon, the agent named in said ordinance passed by said village, of the filing and the time and place for hearing said petition, and directing the said Emmett & Braumon to cause all the duties to be performed in regard thereto, as required by statute in such cases made and provided.

Amended Petition

To the County Commissioners of Perry County, State of Ohio.

On leave of the board of County Commissioners first had and obtained the leave is given the village of Brooksville Perry County, Ohio, to file an amended petition herein. The Village of Brooksville, Perry County, Ohio respectfully represents that by an ordinance duly passed by its council on the 4th day of September 1906, the following described territory, to wit; Beginning at the north east corner of the north west quarter of section No. 21, township number 14, range 14, Perry County, Ohio, thence north twenty six hundred and forty feet thence west eighteen hundred and ten feet, thence north 36.1/2 degrees east sixteen hundred and seventeen feet, thence west seventeen hundred and eighty five feet, thence south thirteen hundred and twenty feet, thence west twenty six hundred and forty feet, thence south thirteen hundred and twenty feet, thence east twenty feet, thence west thirteen hundred and twenty feet, thence south thirteen hundred and twenty feet, thence east thirteen hundred and twenty feet, thence south twenty six hundred and forty feet, thence east twenty nine hundred and sixty feet, thence east two thousand and sixty eight feet, thence north three thousand six hundred and eighty feet to the place of beginning containing exclusive of the present corporation five hundred and sixty eight and 65/100 acres, and being all of said territory embraced within the above described boundary and outside of the present boundary lines of the corporation of Brooksville, which is as follows, to wit; - Beginning at the north west corner of the north east quarter of section number 20, township 14, range 14, Perry County, Ohio.
