M. at their office in the Court House, at New Lexington Perry County Ohio: and thereupon, on Feb. 28, 1907. at 10 o'clock A. M. said Commissioners met at their office in the Court House pursuant to said adjournment, and upon full consideration of said petition and amended petition, said map and plat, and said ordinance, and said notices heretofore referred to, the Board duly find, consider and adjudge that each and all of the requirements of the statute have been duly and legally complied and that the territory sought to be annexed is not unusually large or small and that it is equitable, right and just, and that said Territory should be annexed

It is therefore hereby considered, ordered and adjudged by the Board of County Commissioners of Perry County, Ohio that the prayer of said petition, amended petition, map and plat be granted, and that the territory described in said amended petition may be annexed to the said village of Crooksville, in accordance with law, and that a certified transcript signed by a majority of this Board, of all of the orders and proceedings of this Board relative to said petition and amended petition and herein thereon, together with said petition, amended petition, and map attached thereto, and all other papers on file relating to said matter, be deposited with the clerk of said village of Crooksville, Perry County Ohio, to all of which ruling and holding the remonstrators by their attorneys J. D. Price and M. W. Bradshaw, excepted and their exceptions are here noted at their request.

Ordinance No. 246.

Accepting application for annexation of territory.

Be it ordained by the Council of the village of

Crooksville, Perry County, Ohio: Section 1, That the application of Emmett B. Beaman and others for the annexation of the following described territory, in the County of Perry, State of Ohio, and adjacent to the village of Crooksville, Perry County, Ohio:

Beginning at the north east corner of the northwest quarter of Section No 21, Township No 14, range No 14 Perry County, Ohio, thence north twenty six hundred and forty feet; thence west eighteen hundred and ten feet; thence north thirty six and a half degrees east sixteen hundred and sixteen feet; thence west seventeen hundred and eighty five feet; thence south thirteen hundred and twenty five feet; thence west twenty six hundred and forty feet; thence south thirteen hundred and twenty feet; thence west thirteen hundred and twenty feet; thence south thirteen hundred and twenty feet; thence east thirteen hundred and twenty feet; thence south twenty six hundred and forty feet; thence east twenty nine hundred and sixty feet; thence south twelve and a half degrees east, two hundred and sixty five feet; thence east two thousand and sixty eight feet; thence north three thousand six hundred and eighty feet to the place of beginning containing exclusive of the present Corporation five hundred and sixty eight and sixty five one hundredths acres, and being all of said Territory embraced within the above described boundary and outside of the present boundary line of the Corporation of Crooksville, which is as follows, to wit
