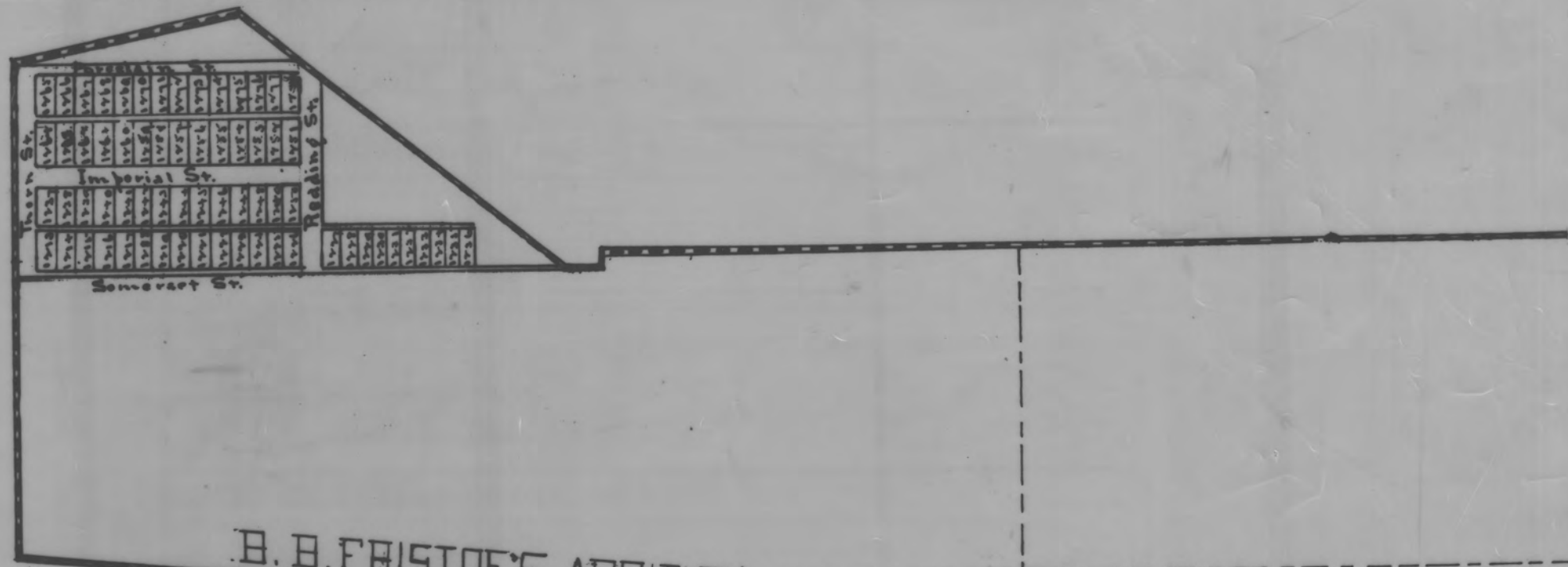


CORPORATE LIMITS

SUNNYSIDE ADDITION.

Sunnyside Addition is part of the southeast quarter of section 5, township 15, range 15, Perry Co. O. beginning at the center of Hogan Street at the north side of Somerset Street, thence north 1.29 chains; thence north 20 3/4° east 8.73 chains; thence south 58 3/4° east 13.31 chains; thence south 27 links; thence west 21.84 chains to the place of beginning, containing 14 2/5 acres.

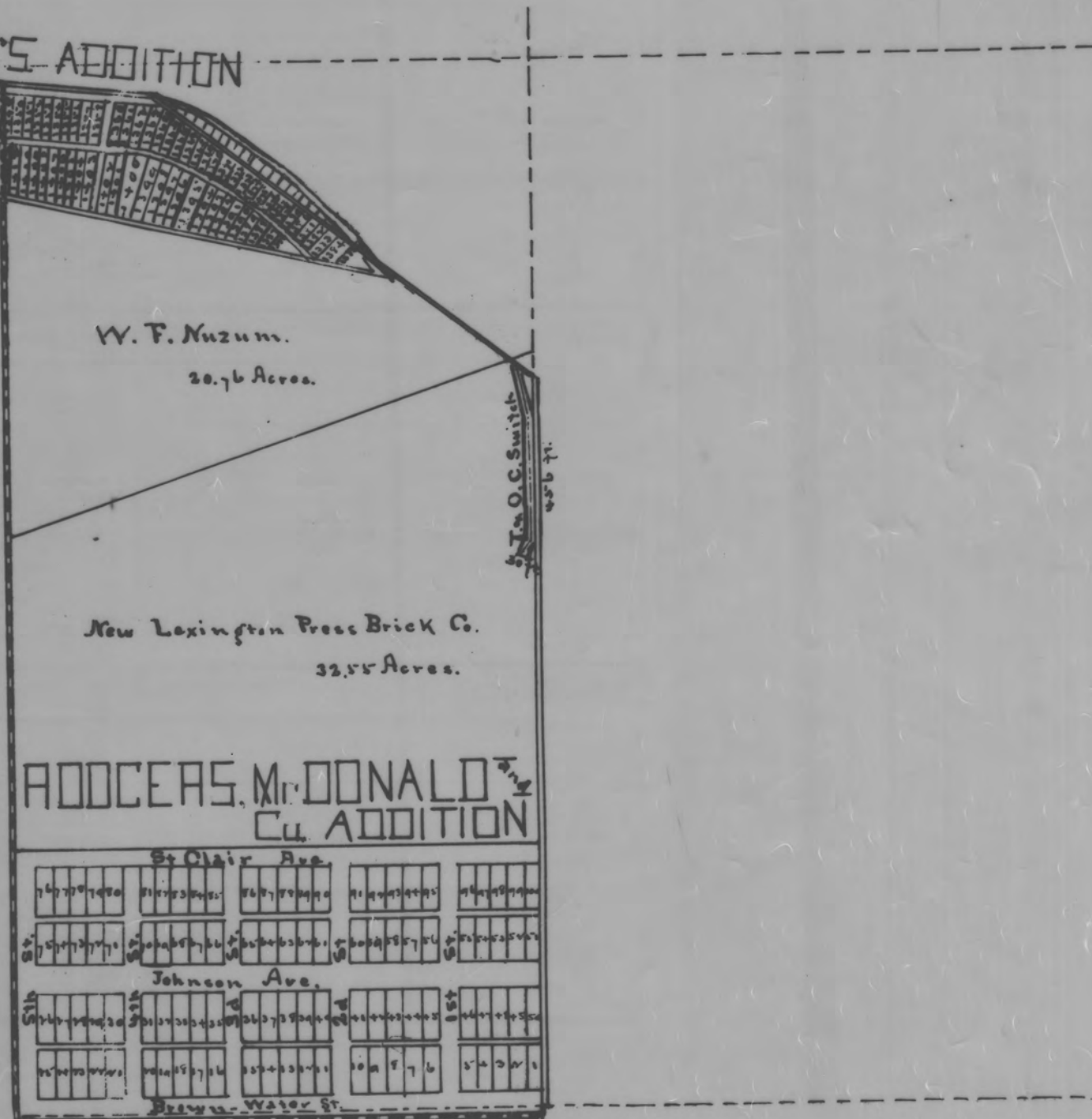


The B. B. Fristoe's addition is a part of the northeast quarter of section 7, township 15, range 15, Perry County, Ohio, beginning at the southwest corner of said quarter section, thence north 27 1/2° east 20 1/2 feet; thence south 80 1/2° east 25 feet; thence north 50° west 4 1/2 feet to the place of beginning; thence S. 80 1/2° E. 113 1/2 ft; thence N. 21° E. 5, 000 3/4 ft; thence S. 58 3/4° E. 17 1/2 ft; thence S. 47 3/4° E. 104 1/2 ft; thence S. 47 3/4° E. 112 1/2 ft; thence N. 75 3/4° W. 14 1/4 ft; thence N. 56° W. 113 1/2 ft; thence N. 46 1/2° W. 129 1/2 ft; thence N. 55 1/2° W. 16 1/2 ft; to the place of beginning, containing 8 3/5 acres.

The W. F. Muzum tract is part of the northeast quarter of section 8, township 15, range 15, Perry Co. O. beginning 1560 feet north of the southeast corner of the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of said section 8, thence north 95 1/2 feet; thence south 24 1/2° east 404 feet; thence south 80 1/2° east 1070 feet; thence south 77° west 1773 feet to the place of beginning, containing 20.76 acres.

The New Lexington Press Brick Co. tract is part of the northeast quarter of section 8, township 15, range 15, Perry Co. O. beginning 650 feet north of the southwest corner of the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of said section 8, thence north 93 feet; thence north 77° east 1223 feet; thence south 80 1/2° east 100 feet; thence south 1100 feet; thence west 1370 feet to the place of beginning, containing 27.55 acres.

The Rodgers, McDonald & Co. Addition is the south half of the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of section 8, township 15, range 15, Perry County, O. containing 3/8 acres.

Transcript of Proceedings in the matter of the Annexation of Territory to the Village of New Lexington, Perry County, Ohio.

Council Chamber, January 14, 1907.

Council met in regular session with Mayor Strickland in the chair. Members present at roll call: Childs, Courtright, Meenan, Sanders, Stovall and Yaw. Absent none. Motion of Yaw, second of Childs, that a committee consisting of three members of this council be appointed by the Mayor, to look into the matter of straightening the corporation line and annexing additional territory to the village of New Lexington, Ohio, was unanimously carried. The Mayor thereupon appointed on said committee Messrs. Yaw, Childs and Meenan, with instructions to report as soon as possible.

Motion of Courtright, second of Meenan, council adjourned.

Council Chamber, May 28, 1907.

Council met in regular session with Mayor Strickland in the chair. Members present at roll call: Childs, Courtright, Meenan, Sanders, Stovall and Yaw. Absent, none. The minutes of previous meeting were read and approved, and ordered filed upon the journal. The annexation committee reported in writing, as follows: We, your committee, appointed to examine map of territory to be annexed to the village of New Lexington, Ohio, beg to submit as follows. We have examined the map submitted some time ago and find same correct and recommend the adoption of the same, and we hereby authorize our City Solicitor to draw an ordinance incorporating said territory.
