

Township of Perry, County of Perry and State of Ohio, and further bounded and described as follows

1st Parcel. (Benny Bide Addition to said village of New Lexington, Ohio) Being a part of the southeast quarter of section 5, township 15, range 15, beginning at the center of Thom Street in said village of New Lexington, Ohio, at the north side of Somerset Street in said village, thence north 7.74 chains; thence north 53 1/2 east 7.74 chains; thence south 53 1/2 east 11.5 chains; thence south 77 1/2 west 11.5 chains to the place of beginning, containing 10.00 acres.

2d Parcel. (W. F. Nugent Tract.) Being a part of the northeast quarter of section 9, township 15, range 15, beginning 150 feet north of the southwest corner of the northeast quarter of said section 9, thence north 90 feet; thence south 74 1/2 east 100 feet; thence south 50 1/2 east 100 feet; thence south 77 1/2 west 100 feet to the place of beginning containing 20.76 acres. This tract contains a part of B. B. Foster's Addition to said village of New Lexington, Ohio.

3d Parcel. (The New Lexington Press Block Company's Tract.) Being a part of the northeast quarter of section 8, township 15, range 15, beginning 60 feet north of the southwest corner of the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter of said section 8; thence north 90 feet; thence north 77 1/2 east 100 feet; thence south 50 1/2 east 100 feet; thence south 110 feet; thence west 130 feet to the place of beginning, containing 27.50 acres.

4th Parcel. (Rodgers, McDonald Company's Addition to said village of New Lexington, Ohio.) Being the south half of the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of section 8, township 15, range 15, containing 20 acres.

5th Parcel. (Jane King Tract.) Being a part of the northeast quarter of section 9, township 15, range 15, beginning at the southeast corner of said quarter section; thence west 37 feet; thence north 20 feet; thence east 37 feet; thence south 20 feet to the place of beginning containing 1/4 acre.

6th Parcel. (J. W. Darby Tract.) Being a part of the northeast quarter of section 9, township 15, range 15, beginning 30 feet west of the southwest corner of said quarter section; thence west 10 feet; thence north 20 feet; thence east 10 feet; thence south 20 feet to the place of beginning, containing 1/4 acre.

7th Parcel. (Nelson Fielder Tract.) Being a part of the northeast quarter of section 9, township 15, range 15, beginning 50 feet west of the southeast corner of said quarter section; thence west 50 feet; thence north 20 feet; thence east 50 feet; thence south 20 feet to the place of beginning, containing 1/4 acre.

8th Parcel. (F. J. Tracy's Addition to the village of New Lexington, Ohio.) Being a part of the southeast quarter of section 9, township 15, range 15, beginning at a stone on the quarter section line; 7 rods west of the southeast corner of said quarter section; thence west 22 rods; thence south 20 rods; thence east 22 rods; thence north 20 rods to the place of beginning, containing 10 acres.

9th Parcel. (J. H. Martin Tract.) Being a part of the southeast quarter of section 9, township 15, range 15, beginning 64 feet north of the southwest corner of said quarter section; thence north 70 feet; thence south 53 1/2 east 91 feet; thence south 31 1/2 west 55 feet to the place of beginning, containing 7.50 acres.

10th Parcel. (George E. King's Tract.) Being a part of the southeast quarter of section 9, township 15, range 15, beginning at the southwest corner of said quarter section; thence north 64 feet; thence east 55 feet; thence south 31 1/2 west 77 feet; thence west 20 feet to the place of beginning, containing 5 1/4 acres.

11th Parcel. (Deeds of Ohio Rural Rights of way.) Being a part of the southeast quarter of section 9, township 15, range 15, beginning 137 1/2 feet north of the southwest corner of said quarter section; thence north 64 feet; thence south 53 1/2 east 90 feet; thence south 31 1/2 degrees west 61 feet; thence north 53 1/2 west 90 feet to the place of beginning, containing 1 1/4 acres.

12th Parcel. (D. C. Fowler Tract.) Being a part of the southeast quarter of section 9, township 15, range 15, beginning at a point 140 feet north of the southwest corner of said quarter section; thence north 46 degrees east 130 feet; thence north 79 1/2 east 20 feet; thence south 610 feet; thence south 59 1/2 west 107 feet; thence south 41 1/2 west 60 feet; thence south 50 1/2 east 100 feet; thence south 31 1/2 west 200 feet; thence north 53 1/2 west 91 feet to the place of beginning, containing 10 1/2 acres.

13th Parcel. (J. C. Fowler Tract.) Being a part of the southeast quarter of section 9, township 15, range 15, beginning at the southwest corner of F. J. Tracy's Addition to the village of New Lexington, Ohio; thence north 31 1/2 west 60 feet; thence north 50 1/2 west 20 feet; thence north 41 1/2 east 60 feet; thence north 59 1/2 east 107 feet; thence south 140 feet to the place of beginning, containing 2.95 acres.

Section 2. That W. A. Allen, as agent and attorney for said village of New Lexington, Ohio, be and he is hereby authorized to prosecute the proceedings necessary to effect such annexation.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Shall the foregoing ordinance be adapted as read, was balloted upon as follows: Ayes: Childs, Gentry, G. Menon, Saunders and yaw; Nays: Strickland. Motion carried and the Mayor declared ordinance adapted as read.

As accurate map and plat of which territory is hereto attached. And W. A. Allen, as agent and attorney for said village is hereby authorized to act as agent for the petitioner in procuring such annexation. And the said village respectfully petitions that said territory may be annexed to said village.

The Village of New Lexington, Perry County, Ohio, respectfully represents that, by an ordinance duly passed by its Council on the 11th day of March, 1907, the following described territory was authorized to be annexed to said village to wit: It follows of real estate, the same description given in the ordinance above copied. As accurate map and plat of which territory is hereto attached. And W. A. Allen, as agent and attorney for said village is hereby authorized to act as agent for the petitioner in procuring such annexation. And the said village respectfully petitions that said territory may be annexed to said village.

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Journal Entry, June 3, 1907.

This day a petition of the incorporation of the village of New Lexington, Perry County, Ohio, was presented to the Board of County Commissioners, applying for the annexation of certain contiguous territory to said village, and the Board of County Commissioners being in regular session and being fully advised in premises, and the said petition being such that, under an ordinance of the Council of said village New Lexington, passed March 11, 1907, the territory therein described was authorized to be annexed to said village of New Lexington, and said petition containing an accurate description of the territory proposed for annexation, and being accompanied by an accurate map thereof, the Board of County Commissioners ordered the petition and map thereof filed with the County Auditor, and hereby fix the time and place for hearing said petition for Tuesday, August 6, 1907, at 10 o'clock A. M. at the Commission office, in the Courthouse, at New Lexington, Ohio.

The County Auditor is hereby directed to notify W. A. Allen, the agent named in said ordinance passed by said village, of the filing and the time and place for hearing said petition and directed the said W. A. Allen to cause all the duties to be performed in regard hereto as required by statute in such case made and provided.

This day the Commissioners of the County of Perry, State of Ohio, proceeded to hear the petition of the village of New Lexington, Ohio, to obtain the annexation of territory in its petition described, to the said village of New Lexington, Ohio, and having in open meeting heard all the persons desiring to be heard for or against the granting of said petition, and having considered the affidavits presented with reference thereto, and being fully advised in the matter, find that said petition contains all the matter required by law; that its statement on true; that the territory sought to be annexed is adjacent to the said village of New Lexington, Ohio; that the petition contains a full description of said territory; that the map of said territory attached to said petition is accurate; that said petition is signed by the village of New Lexington as required by law; that the required legal matter of the time and place of hearing said petition has been given by publication and posting notices as required by law, and that it is right and proper that said petition should be granted.
