

Council Chamber, October 12, 1907.

Council met in regular session with Mayor Stuebel in the chair. Members present at roll call, Childs, Conright, Hitchcock, Meenan, Saunders and you. Absent none.

An ordinance accepting application for the annexation of territory to the village of New Lexington Ohio was presented and read the first time and referred to the ordinance committee. The ordinance committee reported favorably on the ordinance accepting application for the annexation of territory to the village of New Lexington, Ohio, recommending its passage. Motion of Saunders, second of Childs, the foregoing report was accepted by unanimous vote of Council.

Motion of Saunders second of Childs that the Statute rules requiring ordinances to be read on three different days be suspended and the ordinance accepting application for the annexation of territory to New Lexington, Ohio, be read the second time and placed upon its passage was balloted upon as follows: Ayes, Childs, Conright, Hitchcock, Meenan, Saunders and you. Nays, none. Motion carried and the ordinance was thereupon read the second time.

Motion of Conright, second of you, that the Statute rules requiring ordinances to be read on three different days be suspended and the ordinance accepting application for additional territory to New Lexington, Ohio, be read the third time and placed upon its passage was ballotted upon as follows: Ayes, Childs, Conright, Hitchcock, Meenan, Saunders and you. Nays, none. Motion carried and the ordinance was thereupon read the third time as follows:

An Ordinance

Accepting application for the annexation of territory to New Lexington, Ohio.

Be it ordained by the Council of the village of New Lexington, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the application of the village of New Lexington, Ohio, for the annexation of the following described territory in the County of Perry, State of Ohio, and adjacent to the village of New Lexington, to wit: (Same description follows as in the ordinance heretofore captioned) the accurate map of which territory, together with the petition for its annexation and the other papers relating thereto, and the certified transcript of the proceedings of the County Commissioners in relation thereto are on file with the Clerk of said village, be and the same are hereby accepted.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
