

To Authorize Annexation of Certain Territory to the Village of Junction City, Perry County Ohio

Whereas, It is now found, ordered and declared by the Council of said village, that the inhabitants in general of said municipal corporation of Junction City, Perry County, Ohio desire to enlarge its corporate limits by the annexation of contiguous territory hereinafter described, and therefore, be it ordained by the Council of said village of Junction City, Perry County, Ohio.

Section 1. That the annexation of the following described territory, to wit: Being a tract of land and a part of the Southeast quarter of Section Three (3), and a part of the North east quarter of Section Ten (10), Township of Stearns (15) Range Sixteen (16) Perry County Ohio, beginning at the South east corner of said Section No. 3. thence North 1023 feet thence west 1339 feet to the place of beginning; thence West 1100 2/3 feet; thence South 16 1/2 feet thence West 298 1/3 feet; thence South 1376 1/2 feet; thence East 835 feet; thence North 735 feet; thence east 564 feet; thence North 658 feet to the place of beginning containing 35 7/100 acres.

Section 2.- That H. E. Guinsler Chairman ordinance committee and Atty. R. M. Small be and are hereby authorized to prosecute the proceedings necessary to effect such annexation

Section 3- That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
