Accepting the application for the annexation of territory to Junction City, Ohio.

Section One: That the application of the village of Junction City Perry County, Ohio for the annexation of the following described territory in the County of Perry and State of Ohio and adjacent to the village of Junction City to wit:

Being a part of the southeast quarter of section 3 and a part of the north east quarter of section 10 Township 15 Range 16 Perry County Ohio Beginning at the south east corner of said section 3, thence north 1025 feet thence west 1339 feet to the place of beginning thence west 1100 ²/₃ feet thence south 16 ¹/₂ feet thence west 298 ¹/₃ feet thence south 1376 ¹/₂ feet thence east 835 feet thence north 735 feet thence south 564 feet thence north 658 feet to the place of beginning containing 5 ⁸/₁₀₀ acres
