the place of beginning:

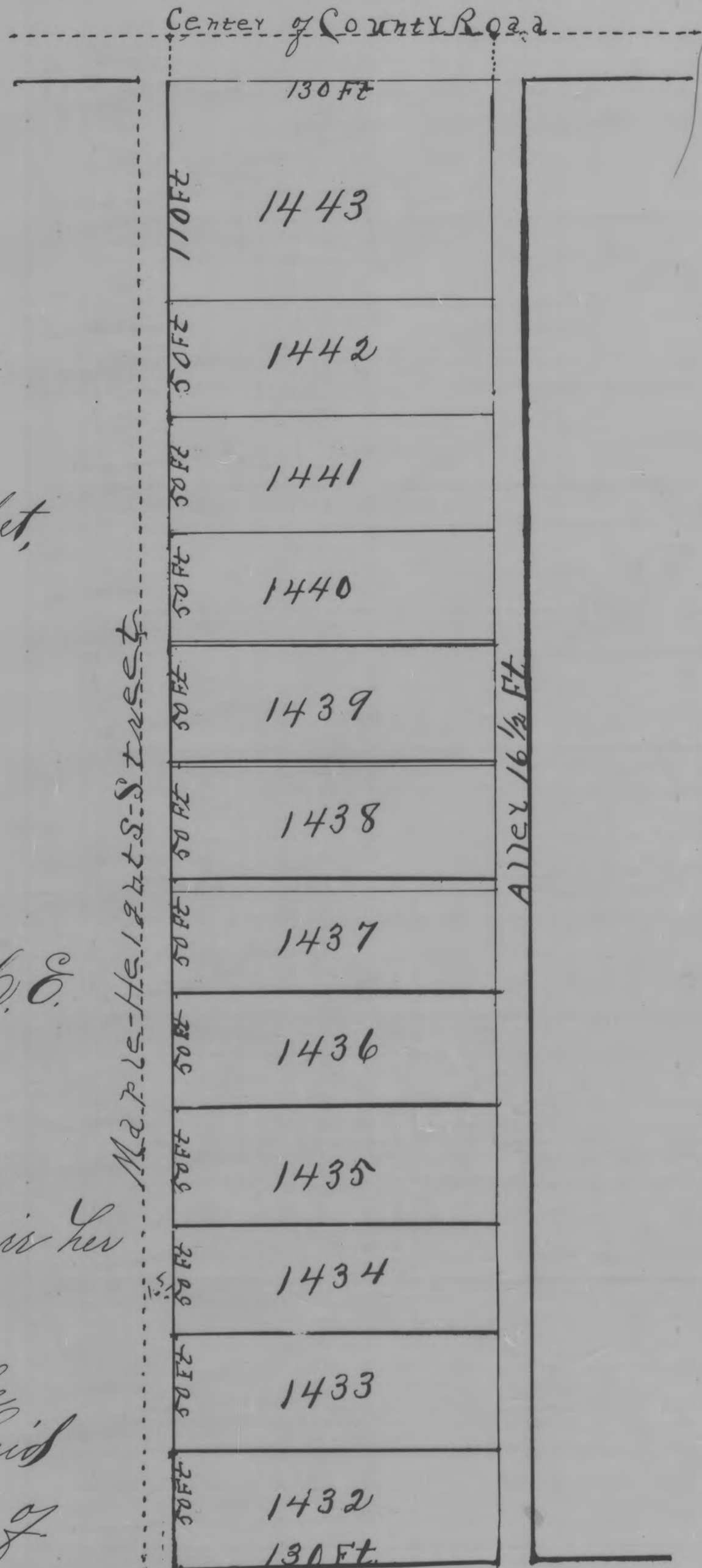
Thence South 660 feet, Thence East 163 feet,
