Thence South 83 3/4° East 150 feet to Church Street, thence along the said Street South 6° West 293 feet. Thence South 31° East 447.4 feet. Thence North 59° East 25 feet to the place of beginning. Thence North 59° East 165 feet. Thence South 31° East 330 feet. Thence South 59° West 165 feet. Thence North 31° West 330 feet to the place of beginning and containing one and one fourth (1 1/4) acres.
