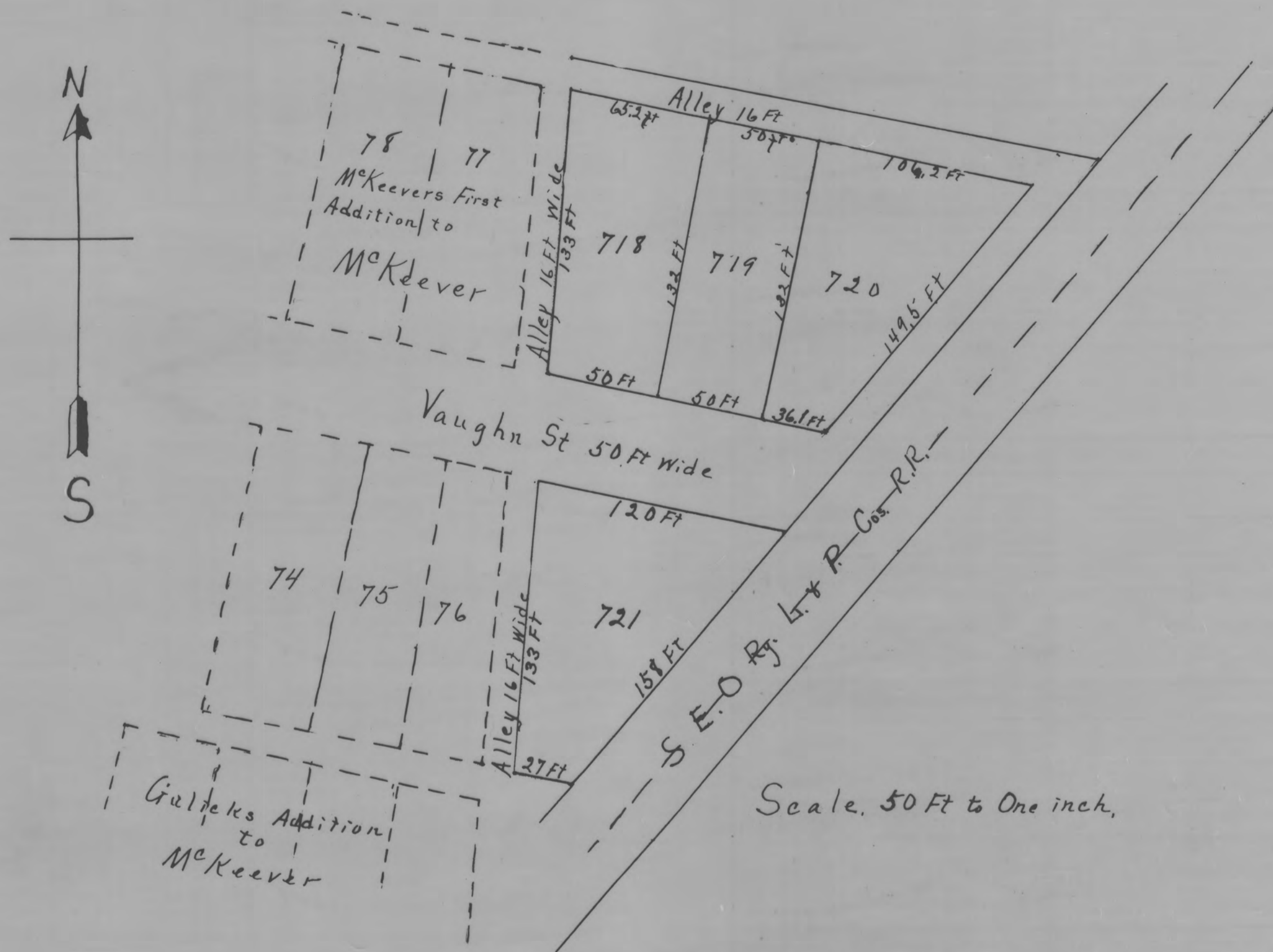


FOURTH ADDITION TO M^cKEEVER



This tract is a part of the north half of the south east quarter of Section No. 17 - Township No. 14, Range No. 14 Perry County Ohio.

Beginning at the South West corner of said half quarter section, Thence East 19 Chains Thence North 6° East 202 feet. Thence North 16° East 699.7 feet. Thence S. 74° E. 380 feet. Thence North 16° East 814 feet. Thence South 74° East 430.6 feet. Thence North 6° East 16 feet to the place of beginning.

Thence South 78 1/4° East 261.4 feet. Thence South 40 1/4° West 222.5 feet. Thence South 43 1/4° West 158 feet. Thence North 78 1/4° West 31 feet. Thence North 6° East 332 feet to the place of beginning
