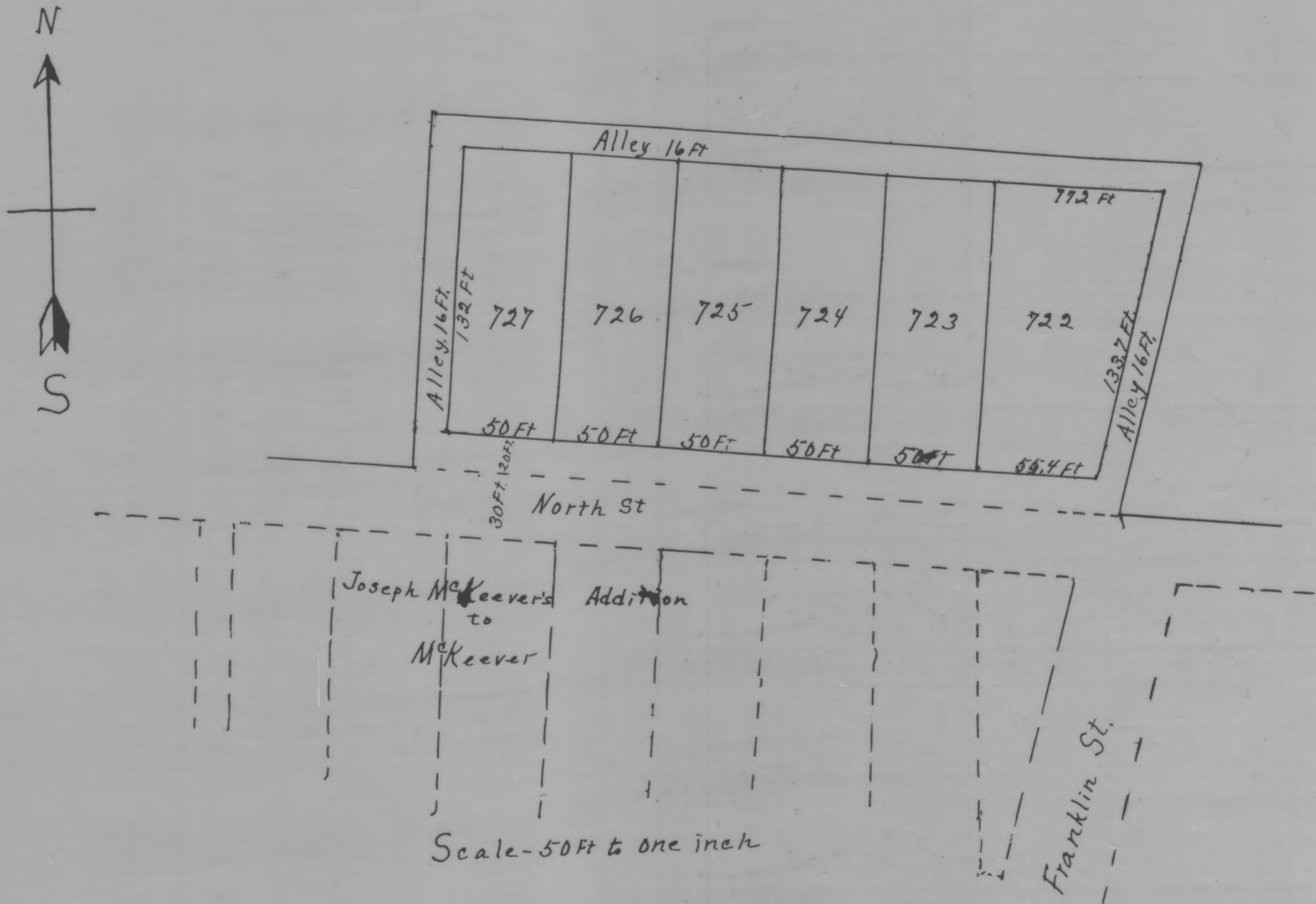


FIFTH ADDITION

This tract is a part of the North half of the South East quarter of section No. 17 Township No. 14 Range No. 14 Perry County, Ohio.
Beginning at the South West corner of said half quarter section. Thence North $58\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ East 537 feet Thence North $45\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ East 281 feet. Thence North $67\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ East 93.1 feet. Thence North $83\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ West 20 feet. Thence North $6\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ East 148 feet to the place of beginning.
Thence South $83\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ East 360.2 feet. Thence South $15\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ West 170.7 feet. Thence North $83\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ West 337.9 feet. Thence North $6\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ East 168 feet to the place of beginning. Containing $1\frac{34}{100}$ Acres
