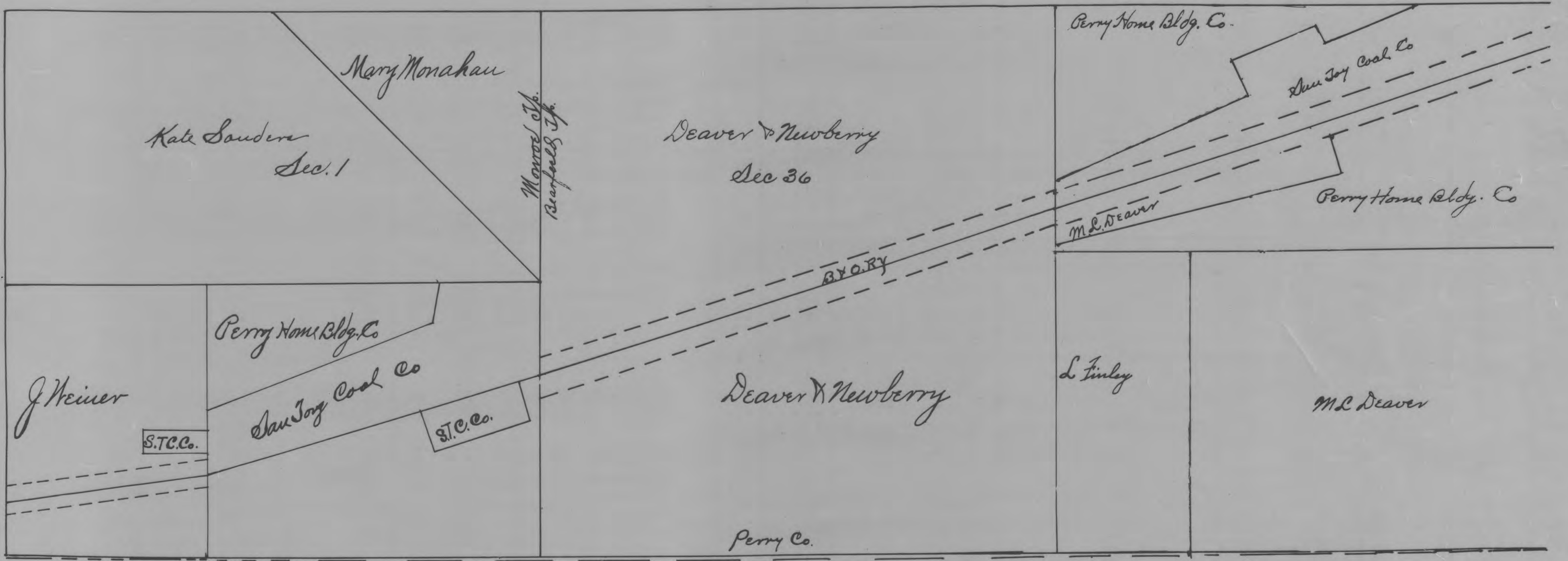


In the matter of the application for incorporation of the Village of Sautoy, Ohio.  
Transcript from record of the Clerk of Bearfield Township, Aug 23, 1913  
This day came Thomas W. Walpole and J. M. Potter Agents for the petitioners and filed with  
the Trustees of Bearfield Township, Perry County, Ohio, the following petition to-wit:

In the Matter of the Application for incorporation of the village of Sautoy, Ohio. Petition.  
To the Honorable Board of Trustees of Bearfield Township, Perry County, Ohio:

The undersigned, being thirty electors, a majority of whom are freeholders, and all of whom  
reside within the following described territory, situate in the County of Perry and State of Ohio  
to-wit: The East half of Section 36, Bearfield Township and the north east quarter of Section one of Monroe  
Township Perry County, Ohio. An accurate map of which territory is attached hereto, respectfully represent  
that the number of inhabitants residing within said territory is about 65 and respectfully petition your  
honorable body that said territory may be organized into a village in the manner provided by law and  
that the name of said village may be "The Village of Sautoy Ohio" and here designate Thomas W. Walpole and J. M. Potter the  
agents to act for them in all matters relating to the hearing upon this petition and any other matter relating to the  
incorporation of said territory into a village and further petition your Honorable Body that an election may be ordered to obtain the  
sense of the electors of said territory upon the question of its incorporation into a village as prayed for in this petition.

This day the Trustees of Bearfield, Township, Perry County, Ohio, met in special session  
at the usual place of meeting, for the purpose of taking action upon the petition heretofore filed  
for the purpose of incorporating the territory therein described as the Village of Sautoy, Ohio,  
and said Trustees being fully advised in the premises do upon unanimous vote make the  
following finding and order:

In the matter of the application for incorporation of the Village of Sautoy, Ohio.

Whereas, a petition has been presented to the Trustees of the Township of Bearfield, County of Perry,  
Ohio, signed by J. A. Falconer, and others, to-wit: Said petition being signed by thirty persons,  
praying that the following described territory, to-wit:

The East half of Section thirty-six of Bearfield Township and the north-east quarter of Section one of  
Monroe Township, Perry County, Ohio, may be incorporated into a village, as provided by law, and  
whereas said Trustees after hearing all evidence submitted are fully satisfied that a majority of the  
inhabitants of the territory aforesaid sought to be incorporated are residents of the said Bearfield Township  
that said petition is signed by the required number of persons, to authorize this proceeding;  
that each of the signors of said petition are electors of the territory above described which is proposed to be  
incorporated and that a majority of the same are freeholders herein and that an accurate map and plat  
of the territory is duly attached to said petition filed herein;

Now therefore be it resolved, that the said territory be and the same is hereby made and declared to be an  
incorporated village by the name of the "Village of Sautoy, Ohio" with the assent of the qualified voters thereof.

Be it further resolved that an election be held on the 4th day of Sept. 1913 to obtain the sense of the  
electors of said territory on the question of incorporation of said territory into the village of Sautoy, Ohio,  
and that such election be held at Stoneburner building Sautoy within the territory herein sought to be  
incorporated.

Be it further resolved that notice of the time and place of holding such election be given by  
publication in New Lexington Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation in said territory and  
by posting written notices thereof in three or more public places in said territory proposed  
to be incorporated for a period of ten days prior to the holding thereof.
