Thence West eight chains and seventy nine links (8.79) ch. to an Iron pipe. Thence North three chains and eighty seven links (3.87) ch. to the South side of the public road. Thence West three chains and thirteen links (3.13) ch. to the right of Way of the Trail Road. Thence S 16 1/2° E one chain and fifty one links (1.51) ch. Thence S 28 1/2° E one chain and fifty one links (1.51) ch. Thence S 11 1/2° E twelve chains and sixty eight links (12.68) ch. Thence S 16 1/2° E one chain and fifty one links (1.51) ch.
