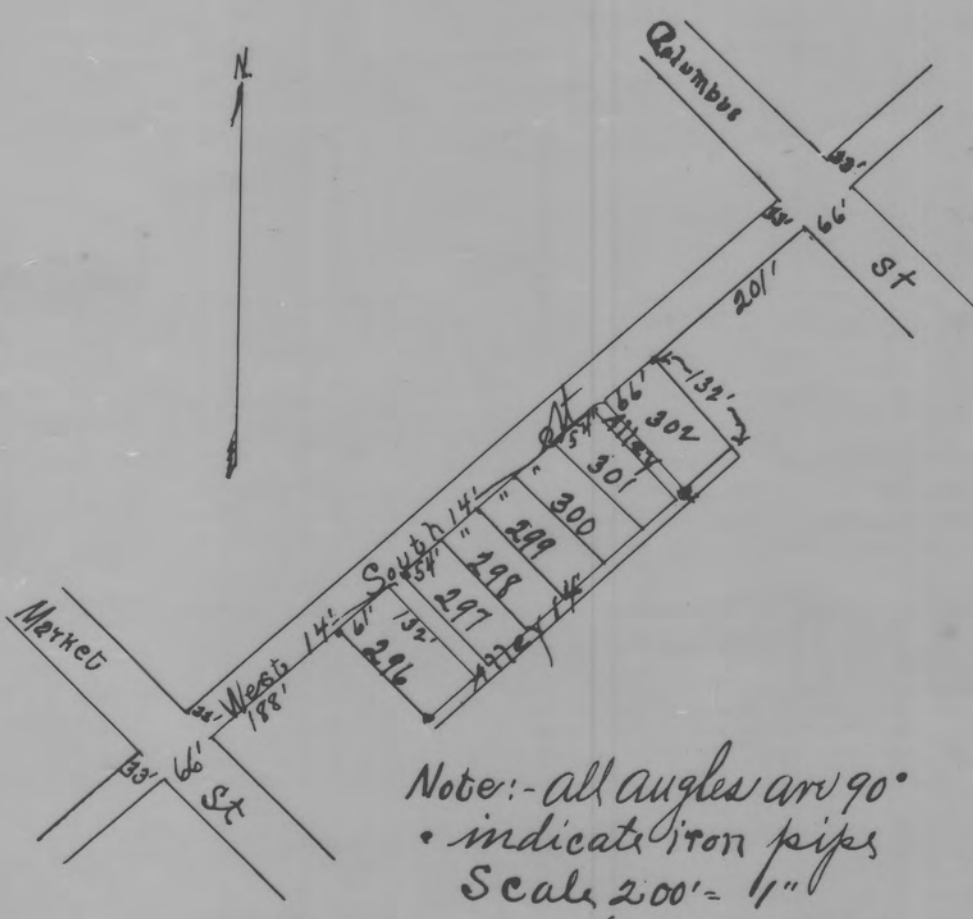


William Snider's First Addition

Description

William Snider's First Addition is laid out on the following described premises:-
 Description:- Situate in the village of Somerset, in Perry County, Ohio, located west of Columbus Street and on and along the south side of South Street, and further described as follows, to wit:
 Beginning at the west corner of the garden, at the residence of the late Owen B. Ryan, which corner is about 214 feet southwestwardly on the south side of said South Street, from the curb at the north corner of said residence and on west side of said South Columbus Street; thence to bound said premises intended hereby to be conveyed and described run southwestwardly, on and along the south side of said South Street, 425 feet, more or less; to north corner of A. E. Conrad's lot, fronting on said last named street; thence ~~northwestwardly~~ ^{westwardly} on line along the west side of said Snider's land; 425 feet, more or less, to south corner of said Garden lot; thence northwestwardly, on and along the line of said Garden lot, 80 feet more or less, to said beginning corner containing 78/100 acres.
