



SECOND ADDITIONAL PLAT

DESCRIPTION

Second Additional Draught of the town of Middleton in the County of Fairfield and State of Ohio. R. Mills, Surveyor.

Note:— The direction of Main St. and the parallel streets and alleys being South 50° West. The cross streets and alleys being South 40° East.

That part of Middleton of which the above is a plat is laid off upon the east half of section nine township 16, range of the land offered for sale at Chillicothe, the Streets and alley cross each other at right angles the direction of Main Street and the parallel Streets and alleys being south fifty degrees west and the cross Streets and alleys being south forty degrees east, the in lots are each four perches by ten containing one fourth part of an acre each, the out lots are each sixteen perches and two thirds by ten perches containing one acre and six perches & two third each except lot No 4 which is bounded as follows: beginning at north eastern corner of West and North Streets and running north 40° W 10 perches thence No 50° E 16 perches to George Trouts line thence South 13 perches thence S 50° W 7.7 containing 118 2/3 perches the Streets and alleys here laid down are given to the inhabitants of said town & the public as also lot No one hundred and sixteen which is hereby given in fee simple for a School house lot & as such the said lot No 116 with its appurtenances is hereby conveyed to the inhabitants of said town their heirs and assigns.
