DESCRIPTION

fourth Supplementary or Additional Draught Of The Town Of Somerset,
In The County Of Fairfield And State of Ohio.

That part of Somerset of which the above is a plat or Draught is laid off upon the west half
of section ten, Township 16, Range 16 of the United States land sold at Chillicothe,

The in lots front each 66 feet each on South Street and run North 40 degrees West 165 feet to
South Alley. South Street is 33 feet wide and the cross alleys are 11 feet wide: the lots are
numbered in numerical order beginning with number 144 on the west (which is only separated from
number 143 of a former Plat by an alley of 11 feet in width), thence proceeding eastward along
South Street to number 149: South Street runs south 50 degrees west.
The Streets and alleys here laid down are given to the public for roads and passages and as such
are hereby conveyed to them and their heirs and assigns forever.

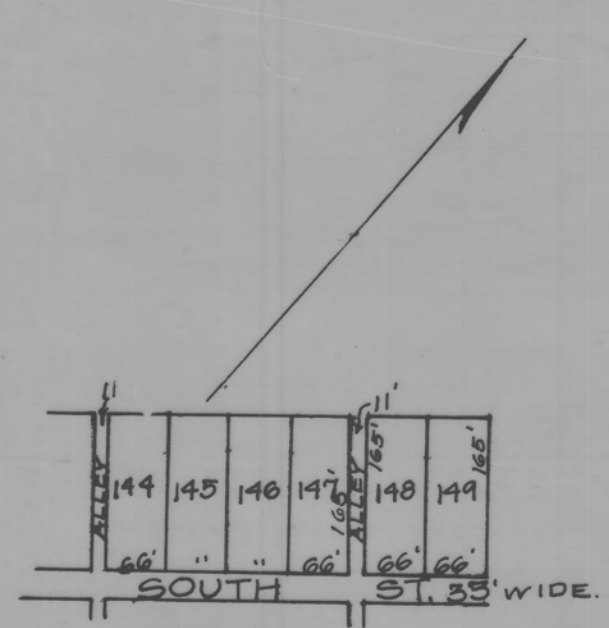
