


Plat of the Town of Perry,
in the County of Perry
and State of Ohio.

Town of Perry of which the above is a plan is laid out on a part of the
 half of Section nine in Township sixteen of Range sixteen, in Perry County, Ohio
 each side of the Road leading from the Eastern Public Square in Somerset to
 Newark which road passes through the street in Perry. The street is sixty six
 wide and runs north forty degree west. The alleys are all sixteen feet and
 half wide. The alleys at the ends of the lots are parallel with the street and
 other alleys run south fifty degree west crossing the street at right angles.
 lots are numbered numerically, beginning on the East side of the street,
 to the Town of Somerset with number one and proceeding North westward
 numerical order to No. eight, thence crossing to the west side of the street,
 south north westward lot is numbered nine, and thence proceeding south
 westward in numerical order to number sixteen opposite No. one. The lots are
 one hundred and sixty five feet in length and fifty feet in width, except
 south west side of No. 9. which from the street measures 160 feet and the
 ends from No 8. measures 45 feet. The intermediate point being cut off with
 a line due north and south. All the alleys and also the street laid down in
 above plat are given to the Inhabitants of said Town of Perry, their heirs
 assigns forever. In testimony of which I, George Trout Sr. proper
 thereof have hereunto set my hand and seal this 12th day of March 1823.
