

THE TOWN OF PERRY OF WHICH THE ABOVE IS A PLAN IS LAID OUT ON A PART OF THE EAST HALF OF SECTION NINE IN TOWNSHIP SIXTEEN OF RANGE SIXTEEN IN PERRY COUNTY, OHIO ON EACH SIDE OF THE ROAD LEADING FROM THE EASTERN PUBLIC SQUARE IN SOMERSET TO NEWARK WHICH ROAD PASSES THROUGH THE STREET IN PERRY. THE STREET IS SIXTY-SIX FEET WIDE AND RUNS NORTH FORTY DEGREES WEST. THE ALLEYS ARE ALL SIXTEEN FEET AND HALF WIDE; THE ALLEYS AT THE ENDS OF THE LOTS ARE PARALLEL WITH THE STREET AND THE OTHER ALLEYS RUN SOUTH FIFTY DEGREES WEST CROSSING THE STREET AT RIGHT ANGLES. THE LOTS ARE NUMBERED NUMERICALLY, BEGINNING ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE STREET WEST TO THE TOWN OF SOMERSET WITH NUMBERS ONE AND PROCEEDING NORTHWESTWARD IN NUMERICAL ORDER TO NO EIGHT, THENCE CROSSING TO THE WEST SIDE OF THE STREET. THE MOST NORTH WESTERN LOT IS NUMBERED NINE AND THENCE PROGRESSING SOUTHEASTERN IN NUMERICAL ORDER TO NUMBER SIXTEEN - OPPOSITE NO ONE. THE LOTS ARE ALL ONE HUNDRED AND SIXTY-FIVE FEET IN LENGTH AND FIFTY FEET IN WIDTH, EXCEPT THE NORTH WEST SIDE OF NO NINE WHICH FROM THE STREET MEASURES 160.5 FEET AND WEST ENDS FROM NO EIGHT MEASURES 45 FEET, THE INTERMEDIATE POINT BEING WEST OFF WITH A LINE DUE NORTH AND SOUTH. ALL THE ALLEYS AND ALSO THE STREET LAID DOWN IN THE ABOVE PLAT ARE GIVEN TO THE INHABITANTS OF SAID TOWN OF PERRY, THEIRS HEIRS AND ASSIGNS FOREVER.

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
