

Notice is hereby given that on the 30th day of March 1914 there was presented to the Board of Commissioners of the County of Perry, State of Ohio a petition signed by a majority of the freehold electors residing in the following described territory, situated in the County of Perry State of Ohio and being a portion of the incorporated village of New Straitsville, to-wit

Beginning at a point which is the N. ORDINANCE 38

An ordinance giving the assent of the council of the village of New Straitsville, Perry County, Ohio to detach certain territory from said village. Whereas, there has been presented a petition by a majority of the electors residing upon the territory hereinafter described, praying that said territory be detached from the municipal corporation of said village of New Straitsville and attached to Coal Township, Perry County, Ohio, being contiguous thereto; and, Whereas, the Council of said Village has assented to the detaching of said territory;

Therefore, Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of New Straitsville, Perry County, State of Ohio as follows: Section 1. - That assent is hereby given by the Council of said Village to detach from the territory of said municipal corporation the following described portion thereof and annex the same to Coal Township, Perry County, Ohio, said portion being described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point, which is the N. E. corner of the present Corporate Limit of the Village of New Straitsville, Ohio, said point of beginning being 660.0 feet, East of N. E. corner of Section #29 Coal Township, Perry County, Ohio; thence South from said point of beginning 1476.0 feet; thence West 1949.0 feet, to West line of N. E. 1/4 of N. E. 1/2 of Section 29; thence North 1476.0 feet to North line of Section #29; thence east along North line of Section #29, 1949.0 feet to place of beginning and containing 66.0 acres, more or less.

Section 2. - This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and legal publication

In the matter of detaching certain territory from the village of New Straitsville, Perry County, Ohio, and attaching the same to Coal Township, Perry County, Ohio

Entry, Order Detaching Territory From Municipal Corporation and Attaching to Contiguous Township

This day this cause came on for hearing before the Board of Commissioners of Perry County, Ohio; and the Board being fully advised in the premises, finds that the Petition herein is signed by a majority of the freehold electors owning lands in the portion of the territory of the municipality sought to be detached herein and attached to said Township. That such portion of territory is accurately described in said Petition, and that an accurate map and plat thereof accompanied the same.

And this Board of Commissioners further find, that the Council of the Village of New Straitsville duly passed an ordinance for that purpose, giving its assent to the detachment of said territory, and in the matter of the apportionment of existing indebtedness of said municipal corporation, it has been ascertained by said Board of Commissioners that the amount of existing indebtedness of said municipal corporation is the sum of \$9,200.00, and that the portion that Coal Township shall assume and pay thereof is the sum of \$70.00 which said apportionment is made in accordance with the valuation as appears upon the tax duplicate of the territories interested herein, to-wit: The village of New Straitsville on the one hand and Coal Township on the other, and said Commissioners further find that said territory ought to be detached from the village of New Straitsville and attached to Coal Township.

It is therefore, by the Board of Commissioners of Perry County, Ohio, ordered and directed that the territory described in the Petition in this cause be and the same hereby is detached from the village of New Straitsville, Perry County, Ohio and attached to the Township of Coal, Perry County, Ohio. And it is further ordered that the Petition, Map, ordinance and this order of the Commissioners be certified by the County Auditor to the County Recorder of this County, and shall be recorded by him in the plat book in his office.
