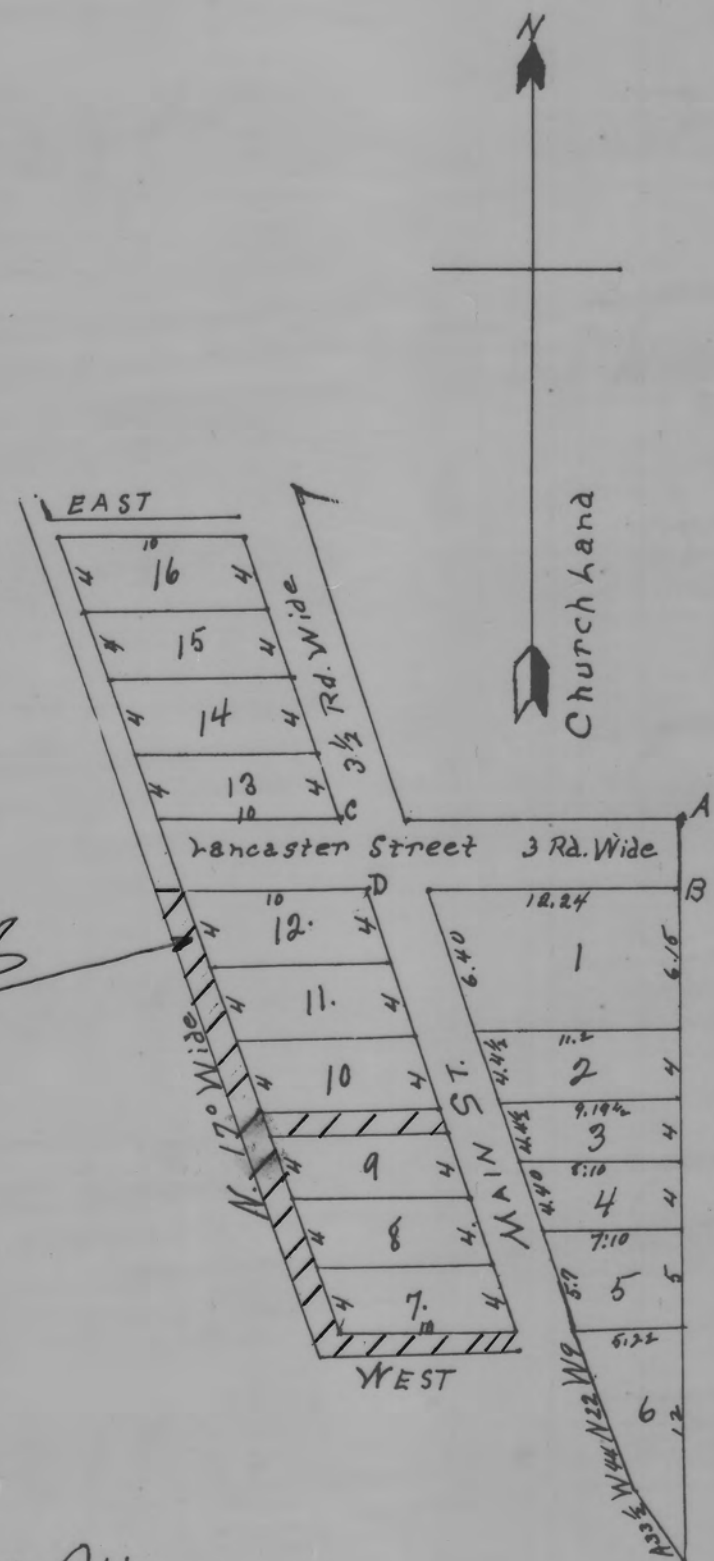

The town lots of Clarksville are laid out on the N. E. 1/4 of section No. 15 Jackson Township, Perry County, Ohio. Lot No 1 commences 81 rods, 20 links south from the N. E. corner of said 1/4 section. Main Street runs N. 17 W. and is 3 1/2 rods wide. The alleys parallel thereto are each 12 feet wide. Lancaster Street runs due east and west and is 3 rods and 1/2 links wide with the bearing of Main Street. The alleys on the east side of said town is half a rod, or 12 1/2 links wide adjoining the section line. Each of the lots west of Main Street contain one-fourth of an acre.
