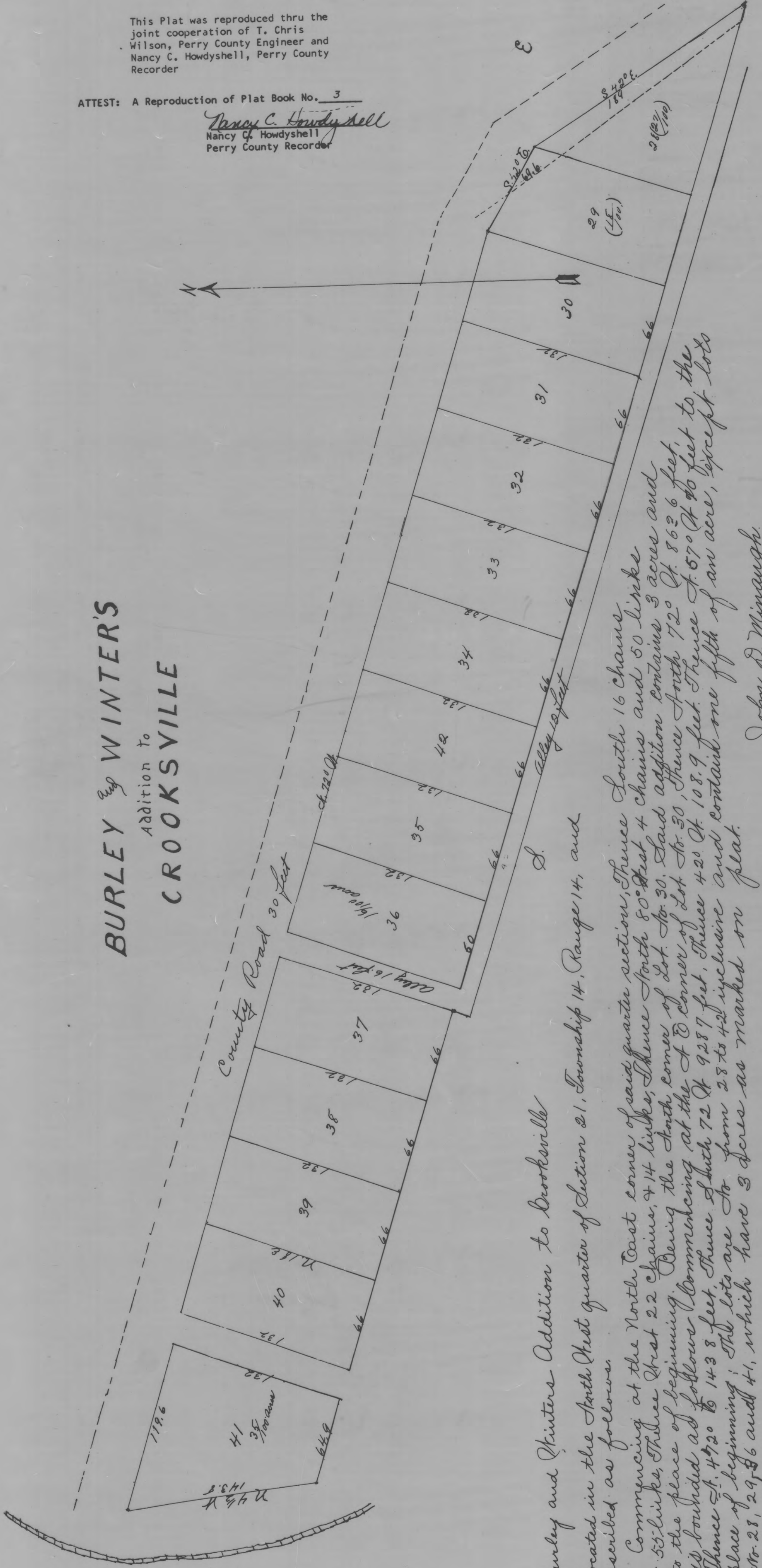

Burley and Winters Addition to Crooksville

Located in the North West quarter of Section 21, Township 14, Range 14, and described as follows.

Commencing at the North East corner of said quarter section, Thence South 16 chains 7.55 links, Thence West 22 chains, 7.14 links, Thence South 80° East 4 chains and 50 links to the place of beginning. Being the North corner of Lot No. 30. Said addition contains 3 acres and is bounded as follows: Commencing at the N. E. corner of Lot No. 30, Thence North 72° E. 862.6 feet, thence S. 72° E. 928.7 feet, Thence South 72° E. 928.7 feet, Thence 42° S. 108.9 feet. Thence A 67° E. 46 feet to the place of beginning; The lots are to form 28 to 42 inclusive and contain one fifth of an acre, except lots Nos. 28, 29, 36 and 41, which have 3 acres as marked on plat.
