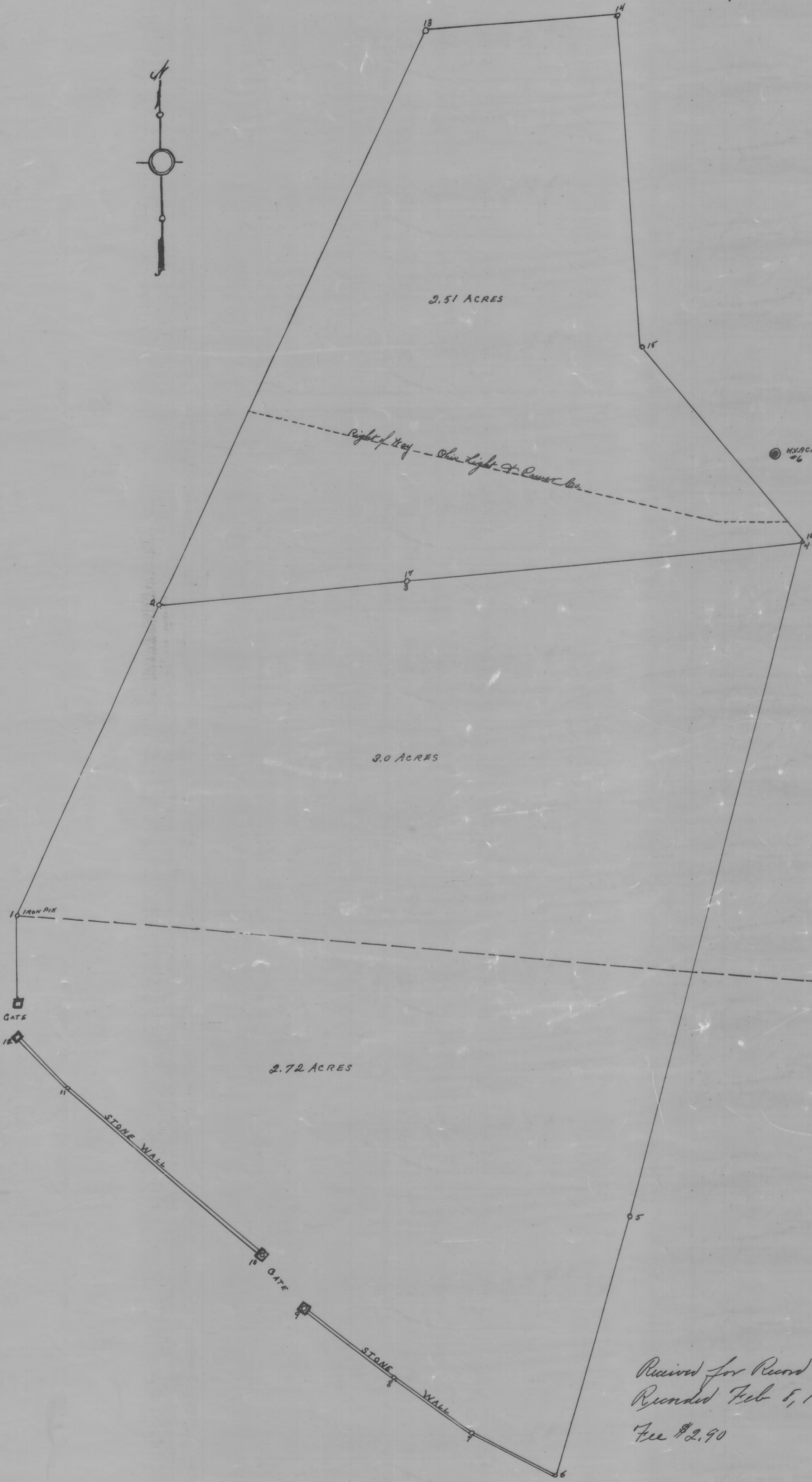


PLAT OF
