

In the matter of detaching certain territory from the Village of New Lexington, Ohio, and attaching the <sup>same to</sup> New Lexington School District Pike Township, Perry County Ohio.

ENTRY

Order detaching territory from municipal corporation and attaching same to contiguous township. This day this matter came on to be heard before the Board of County Commissioners of Perry County, Ohio and the Board being fully advised in the premises finds that the petition herein is signed by J. A. Mc Lane the only elector freeholder, owning lands in the portion of the territory of the municipality sought to be detached therein and attached to said township. That such portion of territory is accurately described in said petition and that an accurate map and plat thereof accompanies the same. And this Board of Commissioners find that the Council of the Village of New Lexington, Ohio duly passed an ordinance for that purpose, giving its consent to the detachment of said territory and said Commissioners find that said territory ought to be detached from the Village of New Lexington and attached to New Lexington School District in Pike Township, Perry County Ohio.

It is therefore, by the Board of Commissioners of Perry County, Ohio, ordered and directed that the territory described in the petition in this cause be and the same hereby is detached from the Village of New Lexington Perry County, Ohio and attached to the New Lexington School District in the Township of Pike, Perry County, Ohio.

And it is further ordered by the Board that the petition, map, ordinance and this order of the Commissioners be certified by the County Auditor to the County Recorder of this County, and shall be recorded by him in the Plat Book in his office.

On the foregoing findings and orders the Board of Commissioners voted as follows: Ricketts, yea; Selby, yea; Shuler, yea. the State of Ohio, Perry County, ss. - Auditor's Office.

This is to certify that the above and foregoing is a true and correct transcript of the proceedings had by and before the Board of County Commissioners of Perry County, Ohio, in the above entitled matter as the same appears of record on the Journal of said Board at page 160 Journal 16, of the records of said Board.

EXHIBIT "C"

Ordinance No. 138 Assenting to the detaching of territory from the village of New Lexington, State of Ohio. Whereas a petition has been presented to the commissioners of Perry County, Ohio by J. A. Mc Lane, a free hold elector of the Village of New Lexington, Ohio, and the owner of the territory herein after described and situated within the incorporated limits of said Village of New Lexington, Ohio, praying that said territory may be detached from said village, therefore,

Be it ordained by the council of the village of New Lexington, State of Ohio: Section 1 - That the consent be and the same is hereby given to the Commissioners of Perry County, Ohio, to detach from the incorporated limits of New Lexington, Ohio the following described territory, petitioned for by J. A. Mc Lane, to-wit: Commencing at the North West corner of lot number 1265 in Sunnyside Addition to the Village of New Lexington, Perry County, Ohio, thence West fifty (50) feet, thence North twenty-four (24) feet, thence North 80 3/4 degrees East 601.2 feet, thence South 53 3/4 degrees East 193 feet, thence West 701 feet to the place of beginning, containing 1.22 acres, said description includes Porcelain Street.

Section 2 - This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law. J. B. Barber, Mayor.
