I, James Brown, an acting Justice of the Peace in and for Perry County aforesaid do hereby certify that this day persons who appeared before me, Jacob Strait & Charity Strait his wife and Isaac Strait and Phoebe Strait his wife parties of the foregoing deed and acknowledged the foregoing to be their voluntary act and deed for purposes therein contained. Afterwards came Charity Strait the wife of Jacob Strait and Phoebe Strait the wife of Isaac Strait and being examined separately and apart from their said husbands and having this said town first fully explained to them they did declare that they did and now doth voluntarily sign, seal and acknowledge the same to be their voluntary act and deed for the special purposes therein contained.
