The lots in Bethlehem are each 66 feet wide and 132 feet long and contain  $\frac{1}{2}$  of an acre each. Lot No 42 and 43 are each 198 feet in front and 132 feet back. Main Street and Alley parallel fronts run due east and west. Market Street and Mulberry Street and Alley running parallel fronts run due North and South. The Alley are 12 feet wide. This town was laid out in October 1834

I, James Kelly, a Justice of the Peace in and for the county of Perry aforesaid, do hereby certify that Harriet Whipple the wife of Ezekiel Whipple parties to the foregoing town plat personally appeared before me in the county aforesaid and being examined by me separately and apart from her said husband and hearing the said town plat fully explained to her by me she declared that she did voluntarily sign, seal and acknowledge the same to be her act and deed for the special purposes therein contained. Also at the same time came the said Ezekiel Whipple and acknowledged the signing and sealing of the said instrument as his voluntary act and deed for the special purposes therein contained.
