

Petition to Vacate Street

To The Council of the Village of Brookville, State of Ohio:

The undersigned, owners of Lots numbered 406, 407 and 408 in the Terrace addition to the Village of Brookville, Ohio, in the immediate vicinity of Pine Street in said Village, between Keystone Street and the alley west of Keystone Street, a distance of about 100 feet, said street being 50 feet in width, respectfully petition your Honorable Body that ten (10) feet on the east (southeast) side of said Pine Street be vacated between the points named, for the reason that it is no longer of use to the public and that its vacation will not be detrimental to the general interest.

The petitioners further state that they own the lots on both sides of said part of street asked to be vacated and that as a result thereof no notice will be necessary, they being the owners of all the lands abutting on said part of street proposed to be vacated, (except the alley at the west end thereof, which is village property), hereby give their written consent to such vacation and ask that the Council pass an appropriate ordinance, vacating the same. A rough sketch or plat is hereto attached, showing that part of the street which the petitioners ask to be vacated, marked Exhibit A.

Ordinance No. 562

To Vacate Pine Street from Keystone Street to the alley West

Whereas, on the 15th day of May, 1939, a petition by persons owning lots in the immediate vicinity of Pine Street from Keystone Street to the alley west, was duly presented to Council, praying that said street between the points named be vacated and they being the owners of Lots numbered 406, 407 and 408 in said street, the same being all the abutting property on the portion thereof asked to be vacated, making unnecessary any notice of the same, as provided by law.

and Whereas, action of Council can be immediately taken on the same.

and Whereas, Council upon hearing is satisfied that there is and was good cause for such vacation, as prayed for.

That it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made

Section 1. That 10 feet on the east (southeast) side of Pine Street from Keystone Street to the alley west be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. That this Ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law

Section 3. That the Clerk be directed to certify a copy of this ordinance to the County Recorder of Perry County, with instructions to correct the plat of the Terrace addition to said village accordingly.
