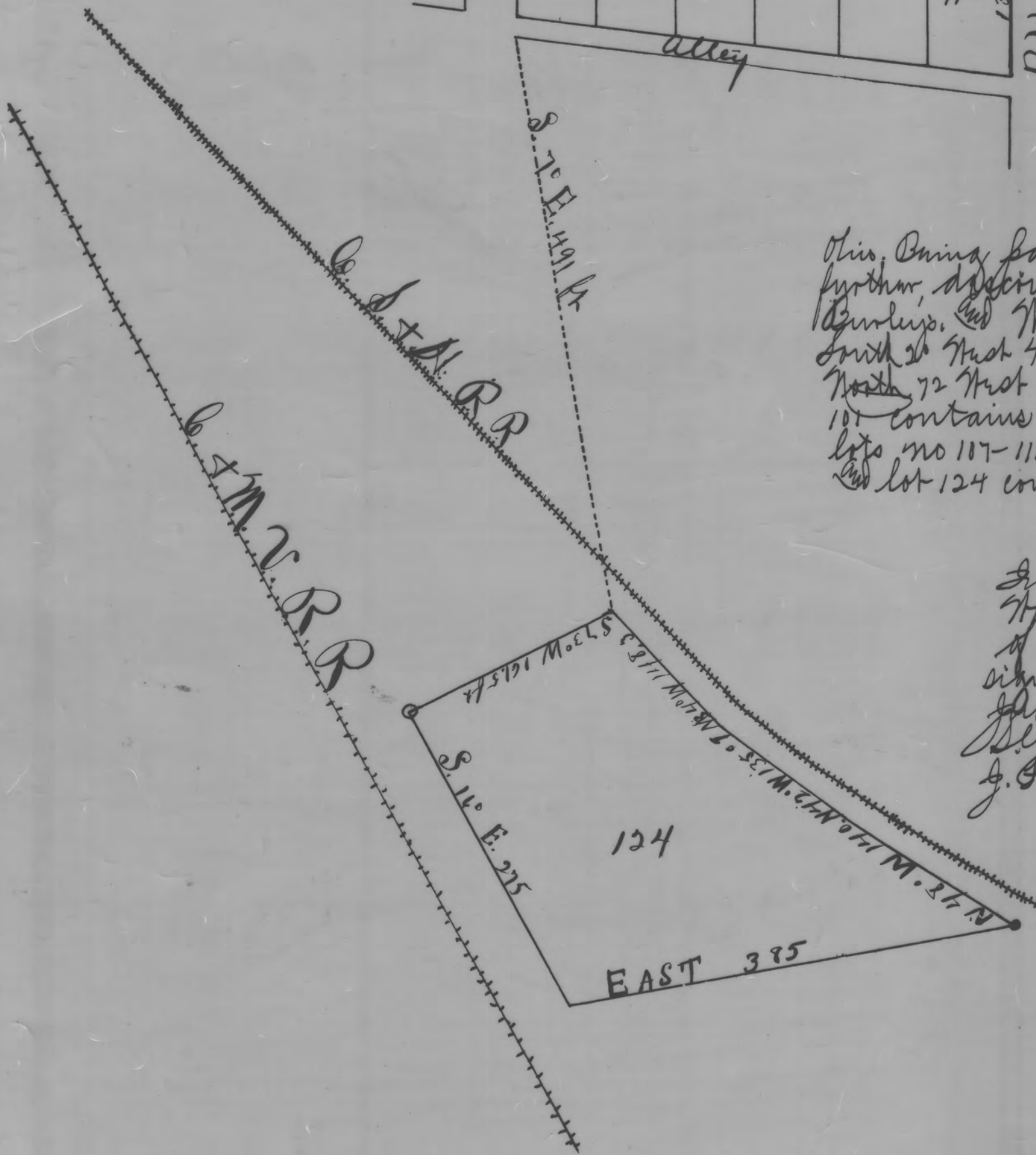


Description of Burley and Winter's 3" Addition to the village of Brookville Ohio, being part of the North West quarter of Section 21, Township 14 Range 14 and further described as follows: commencing at the South West corner of No 69 in Burley, Ohio.
