

McCombs Second Addition lies wholly within the South East quarter of the North West quarter of Section Twentyfour (24), Township Fourteen (14), Range Fifteen (15), Perry County, Ohio. The North West Corner of Lot One Hundred and twenty three (123), is Fourteen (14) Rods East of the Center of said Quarter Section. The North Line of this Addition Coincides with the North Line of the South East Quarter of Said North West Quarter; The East Line of this Addition is at Right Angles with the North Line of the same. THE East Tier of Lots are One Hundred (100) Feet deep, and Fifty (50) front on Caledonia Street; the West Tier is One Hundred and twenty five (125) feet deep, and Forty (40) feet on the Aforesaid Street. The Dimensions of the southernmost Lot of each Tier are given in the Plat in feet. The Lots cover Two (2) acres and Fifteen (15) Hundredths of an acre; The Street and Alley, Fifty Five (55) Hundredths of an acre; Total Two Acres and Seventy (70) Hundredths of an acre. The Street is Forty Four (44) Feet wide, The Alley Fourteen (14) Feet. Iron Pins having a diameter of one (1) inch and a quarter, and Thirty inches Long, are driven into the earth to the depth of two (2) feet, as monuments of reference At the points marked in the Plat. The relation of this Addition to McCombs First Addition is shown in the Plat.
